



ANNOUNCEMENT

The Air Navigation Service (ANS) of the Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines (CAAP) is in need of Airfield Lighting and Power Technician (ALPT) who will be tasked to operate and maintain the airfield lighting and power systems used in different airports nationwide. Successful applicants will undergo competitive training (Basic ALPT Training Course) at the Civil Aviation Training Center (CATC), Merville Access Road, Pasay City. Training is free, however, there will be no allowance or any form of remuneration during the training period.



Place of Examination : Manila (NCR), Kalibo, General Santos, Mactan

Qualification Requirements :
1. Age Requirement : At least (20) but not more than twenty eight (28) years of age on the day of the written examination,
: Qualified CAAP in-service applicants shall not be more than thirty five (35) years of age on the day of the written examination,
 2. Physical/mental condition : Must be physically, mentally fit, and of good moral character (successful examinees will be required to undergo physical, neurological and psychiatric examination).
 3. Educational Background : Completion of two (2) years studies in college, **preferably** with Mechanical, Electrical, Electronics Course or High School Graduate with relevant vocational/Trade Course (Mechanical, Electrical, Electronics),
 4. Eligibility : None Required
 5. Work Experience : None Required

Application forms are available at Human Resource Management Division (HRMD), CAAP, Pasay City (for Manila Applicants) or at the office of Airport Manager, HR Office, ANS Facility-In-Charge (for provincial applicants).

The following must be submitted to the HRMD, Pasay City (Manila Applicants) or at the HR Office (provincial applicants) not later than 5:00PM on or before April 07, 2017:

1. Duly accomplished application form;
2. Copy of Transcript of Records for two (2) years studies in college or copy of diploma together with relevant Vocational/Trade Course Certificate for High School graduate;
3. Copy of Birth Certificate;
4. NBI Clearance.
