This Supplemental/Bid Bulletin is issued to modify, amend or clarify items in the Bidding Documents for the **Construction of New Passenger Terminal Building (Phase I) of Tacloban Airport Development Project.**

1. The new schedule for the Opening of Bids will be on **17 September 2020, 10:00 AM** at 4th Floor CAAP Conference Room, MIA Road, Ninoy Aquino Avenue, 1300 Pasay City, Metro Manila.
2. Minimum requirements for equipment:

Equipment	One (1) Unit Crane (Truck Mounted or Crawler), hydraulic, 61-70 tonnes, 280hp. One (1) Unit Crane (Truck Mounted or Crawler), w/ bucket hydraulic, 36-40 tonnes, 238hp. One (1) Unit Cargo Truck, 11-12 tonner, 290hp. One (1) Unit Hydraulic Excavator/Backhoe, W.M., 0.92 cu.m., 130 hp. One (1) Unit Hammer, Pile w/o Crane, w/60ft. Lead, D46-13. Four (4) Units Transit Mixer, 8.0 - 10.0 cu.yd., 290 hp. Four (4) Units Dump Truck, 9 - 11.99 cu.yd., 275 hp. One (1) Unit Water Truck w/ water pump, 16,000 liters, 360 hp. One (1) Unit Pneumatic Roller (Self-Propelled), 15tonnes, 160 hp. One (1) Unit Wheel Loader, 2.29 cu.m., 150 hp. One (1) Unit Truck Mounted Crane, Hydraulic Telescopic Boom, 21-25MT. One (1) Unit Pumpcrete, 60 cu.yd.(45.87cu.m.), 180 hp.
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Accordingly, Item 1 of Bid Bulletin No. 1 is disregarded.

3. Additional provision for the Scopes of Work of Section Series 6000: Electrical Works of the bidding documents.

“Furthermore, this section also covers the supply of labor, materials, tools and equipment necessary to complete the roughing-in works (Conduits/Raceways, Boxes and Ladder) for Section 6200 Lighting and Wiring Device System (excluding cables) as indicated on the approved plans.”

4. Modification in the revised **Detailed Breakdown of Component of Each Item**, the Value Added Tax (VAT) for Item 1.2 License and Permit will be twelve percent (12%) and the rest will be five percent (5%).
5. Attached revised **Detailed Unit Price Analysis** under Section VIII. Bill of Quantities of the bidding documents.
6. Attached revised approved plans under Section VII. Drawings of the Bidding Documents.

7. Hereunder are the clarifications to the various queries of bidder in connection with the project:

Queries	Clarifications
1. Will the project be contracted based on a Lump Sum Contract or Unit Cost Contract?	The project will be based on Unit Cost Contract.
2. On minimum work experience of key personnel	Please see ITB Clause 12.1(b)(ii.2) under Section III. Bid Data Sheet of Bidding Documents. The minimum requirement for key personnel is five (5) years in General Engineering and three (3) years in Building or Industrial Plant.
3. Are works for Sanitary and Plumbing System, Ventilation and Air Conditioning System, Fire Protection and Electrical Works limited to conduits/ piping/ feeder works only and do not include the equipment?	Scopes of work for Sanitary and Plumbing System, Ventilation and Air Conditioning System, and Electrical Works includes roughing-ins only For Fire Protection System, equipment and piping system are included excluding pumps and valves.
4. On the number Government Engineers and Personnel that will be staying in the staff house and field office	Please see Section 1120: Employers and Engineering Facilities Under Section VI. Scopes of Work and Specification of the Bidding Documents. Provision of Field Office for the Employer and Engineers including Laboratory and Staff House with Electric Power and Water Supply has a minimum area of 250 sq.m. and on a rental basis for eighteen (18) months. Project Management Office (PMO) includes ten (10) CAAP personnel.
5. On clarifications of the function of the formula in DUPA Item D Unit Cost (Equipment & Labor) = (A+B)/C. Do bidders need to follow the Output (Qty/Hr) as provided in the PDF copy?	Bidders shall use the standard or higher capacity/capability output and formula given in the form to determine the unit price for each scope of work. For bid evaluation purposes, capacity/capability output that is lower than the specified standard will be disqualified.
