INVITATION TO BID FOR

PURCHASE/INSTALLATION OF APRON FLOOD LIGHTS AT COTABATO AIRPORT

BID NO 19-039-09 ALPHA

1. The Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines (CAAP) through the CAAP Corporate Budget for CY 2019 intends to apply the sum of **ELEVEN MILLION SEVEN HUNDRED THIRTY TWO THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED NINETY FIVE PESOS ONLY (Php 11,732,395.00)** being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for **PURCHASE/INSTALLATION OF APRON FLOODLIGHT AT COTABATO AIRPORT** Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.

2. The CAAP now invites bids for **PURCHASE/INSTALLATION OF APRON FLOODLIGHT AT COTABATO AIRPORT**. Completion of Work (Delivery of Goods and Installation) is required within **NINETY (90) CALENDAR DAYS** upon receipt of the **NOTICE TO PROCEED**.
Bidders should have completed, within **five (5) years** from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to this Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II. Instructions to Bidders.

3. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using a non-discretionary “pass/fail” criterion as specified in the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) 9184, otherwise known as the “Government Procurement Reform Act”.


(i) Bidding is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, partnerships, or organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines, and to citizens or organizations of a country the laws or regulations of which grant similar rights or privileges to Filipino citizens, pursuant to RA 5183.

4. Interested bidders may obtain further information from CAAP and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below during **8:00AM to 5:00PM**.

5. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by interested Bidders on **September 30, 2019 until deadline of submission of bids** from the address below {Insert if necessary: and upon payment of the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents, pursuant to the latest Guidelines issued by the GPPB, in the amount of Php 25,000.00 .
6. The CAAP will hold a **Pre-Bid Conference on October 15, 2019 at 2:00PM at CAAP BAC Office**, which shall be open to prospective bidders.
7. Bids must be duly received by the BAC Secretariat at the address below on or before **October 29, 2019 2:00 PM**. All Bids must be accompanied by a bid security in any of the acceptable forms and in the amount stated in **ITB Clause 18**.

Bid opening shall be on **2:00PM of October 29, 2019** at CAAP Conference Room. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend at the address below. Late bids shall not be accepted.
8. The CAAP reserves the right to reject any and all bids, declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract at any time prior to contract award in accordance with Section 41 of RA 9184 and its IRR, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
