**Subject: PROVISION OF SECURITY SERVICES REQUIREMENTS FOR CAAP MAIN OFFICE AND NEARBY FACILITIES UNDER A THREE (3) SERVICE AGREEMENT – BID NO. 21-03-06 BRAVO**

**TO ALL PROSPECTIVE BIDDERS:**

This Supplemental/Bid Bulletin clarifies the queries raised during the Pre-bid Conference held last 14 June 2021, and other matters relative to the public bidding for the **Provision of Security Services Requirements for CAAP Main Office and Nearby Facilities under a Three (3) Service Agreement – BID NO. 21-03-06 BRAVO**.

The modifications, amendments or clarifications are as follows:

Special Conditions of Contract GCC Clause 4.0 para 5.</p>

<p>5.) Page 28, Section III. Bid Data Sheet ITB Clause 20.2 Para 5:</p>	<p>e. During the Post Qualification of Bid, the prospective bidder must resubmit and present before the BAC TWG its MDRs within the last three (3) consecutive months prior to the date of Post Qualification of Bid. In compliance with the Private Security Agency Law (R.A. 5487), the BAC TWG shall ascertain and ensure that the cap of 1,000 security guards is not exceeded, taking into account the prospective bidder's projected and/or additional number of guards it shall employ and deploy to CAAP. Violation of this head count requirement shall result in disqualification of bid</p>

Special Conditions of Contract GCC Clause 4.0:</p>	<p>Non-compliance or violation of items stated in clause 4.0 may result in the cancellation or termination of the security services contract, upon recommendation of the Technical Inspection and Acceptance Committee (TIAC) to the HOPE during Technical Inspection and Acceptance.</p>

Upon receipt of the Notice to Proceed, the PSA shall execute a Notarized Undertaking expressing its willingness to undergo periodic reviews, assessment and compliance inspections to ensure that the provisions of the TOR and signed contract security services agreement are faithfully and consistently complied with, and that no law is violated during the life of the security services contract agreement with the Authority.</p>
<p>8.) Page 35, Section V. Special Conditions of Contract GCC Clause 5.0:</p>	<p>7. In accordance with Republic Act No. 5487 otherwise known as the Private Security Agency Law, the PSA shall commit and ensure that it shall not employ more than 1,000 guards during the period of validity of the signed contract security</p>

	services agreement with CAAP, and shall subject itself to periodic review, assessment and compliance inspections. A violation of this requirement shall automatically rescind the validity of the signed security services contract agreement with the Authority.
9.) Basic AVSEC Training Details	Course: Basic AVSEC STP 123 Instructors: CSIS, CAAP Duration: 10 days/80 hours, 8 hours/day (Monday-Friday for two consecutive weeks)

10.) "Who will provide the resource speaker? Or is it the CAAP Training School who will conduct the training of the AVSEC Training?"	The CSIS will provide the instructors for the AVSEC training.
<b>Eaglematrix Security Agency, Inc.</b>	
11.) "Relative sa maximum limit na 1,000, there is a pending bill both in the House and the Senate removing this 1,000 limit. Supposed this bill will take effect what will be effect on this contract?"	Pending the approval of the bill, the end-user stands by its requirement of maximum 1,000 guards as per R.A. 5487.

12.) How many hours the updated AVSEC training? Ilang araw at ilang oras?	Course: Basic AVSEC STP 123 Instructors: CSIS, CAAP Duration: 10 days/80 hours, 8 hours/day (Monday-Friday for two consecutive weeks)

**III.** This shall be an integral part of Bidding Documents and the same shall be enclosed in the technical bid envelope/components and shall be marked accordingly.

**IV.** Bids not complying with the above instruction shall be disqualified.
