SUBJECT : VALIDITY OF THE EXTENDED CAAP ISSUED AIRCRAFT,  
AIRCRAFT MATERIAL DISTRIBUTOR AND APPROVED  
MAINTENANCE ORGANIZATION CERTIFICATES

The Flight Standards Inspectorate Service has progressively resumed to new normal operations. Though operating in a limited capacity, the Airworthiness Department is now accepting applications for registration of aircraft, material distributor and maintenance organization certificates, for prioritization and sequential processing.

In view of this, please be informed that all certificates emanating from the Airworthiness Department, which were extended pursuant to Memorandum Circular No. 10-2020 dated 13 March 2020, will only remain valid until **30 SEPTEMBER 2021**.

Stakeholders are encouraged to submit timely their respective application for registration and certification to avoid untoward disruption of operations.

In the interim, applications will be evaluated and processed through desk audit only and without the mandatory on-site inspection. However, certificates issued under the desk audit procedure will be subsequently scheduled for an on-site audit when travel of inspectors and auditors is permissible.
