



NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC

FSIS OFFICES CLOSES ON MARCH 16-19, 2021

With the current public health emergency on COVID-19, the Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines prioritizes the health and safety of our clients and personnel.

The alarming number of COVID-19 cases in the Flight Standards Inspectorate Service (FSIS) led to the recommendation of the Office of the Flight Surgeon and Aviation Medicine for the immediate lockdown of all FSIS offices to give way for the thorough disinfection and sanitation of its facilities to prevent the spread of the viral infection.

While all FSIS personnel are directed to Work From Home (WFH) during this period and use online platforms in carrying out their official duties, all clients of the FSIS offices are encouraged to conduct their transactions through email instead of face-to-face interactions.


The FSIS will temporarily suspend onsite transactions on *March 16 to 19, 2021 (Tuesday to Friday)* to give way for the disinfection and sanitation activities.
