SUBJECT : AMENDMENT TO PHILIPPINE CIVIL AVIATION
REGULATIONS PART 9; 9.1.1.6 (a)(4)(iv)

Pursuant to the powers vested on the Director General of the Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines under Republic Act No. 9497, otherwise known as the Civil Aviation Authority Act of 2008 and in accordance with the Regulations Amendment/Revision Procedure with Board Resolution No. 2012-054 dated 28 September 2012, I hereby approve the incorporation of the following amendments to the Philippine Civil Aviation Regulations Part 9.

AMENDED REGULATIONS:

PHILIPPINE CIVIL AVIATION REGULATIONS PART 9

9.1.1.6 ISSUANCE OR DENIAL OF AIR OPERATOR CERTIFICATE

(a) The Authority may issue an AOC if, after investigation, the Authority finds that the applicant:

(1) xxx

....

(4) Has at least three (3) aircraft, one (1) of which must be owned by the applicant. The aircraft ownership requirement does not apply to existing AOC holder that meets one of the following:

- (i) Is a citizen of the Republic of the Philippines;
....
(iv) Has a paid-up Capital of at least: ~~Five Hundred Million (P500,000,000.00) Pesos for International Air Operators and Fifty Million (P50,000,000.00) Pesos for Domestic Air Taxi Operators.~~

For International Air Operators:

Scheduled Flights: Eight Hundred Million Pesos
(P800,000,000.00)

Non-Scheduled Flights: One Hundred Fifty Million Pesos
(P150,000,000.00)

For Domestic Air Operators:

Scheduled Flights: Three Hundred Million Pesos
(P300,000,000.00)

Non-Scheduled: Twenty-Five Million (25,000,000.00) Pesos
for Air Taxi

"End of Text"

Separability Clause If, for any reason, any provision of this Memorandum Circular is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the other part or parts thereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

Repealing Clause All orders, rules, regulations and issuances, or parts thereof which are inconsistent with this Memorandum Circular are hereby repealed, superseded or modified accordingly.

Determination of Changes To highlight the amendments and/or revisions in the Memorandum Circular, the deleted text shall be shown with strikethrough and the new inserted text shall be highlighted with grey shading, as illustrated below:

Effectivity Fifteen (15) days after compliance with the requisite publication in a single newspaper of general circulation and a copy filed with the U.P. Law Center – Office of the National Administrative Register, these amendments shall be incorporated to the Philippine CAR, series of 2021.
