**SUBJECT : SUSPENSION OF AEROMEDICAL EXAMINATION IN THE
OFFICE OF THE FLIGHT SURGEON AND AVIATION
MEDICINE**

DATE : 10 JANUARY 2022

In light with the rising number of COVID-19 positive cases in the Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines and to prevent further spread of the virus, the Aeromedical Examination in the Office of the Flight Surgeon and Aviation Medicine (OFSAM) is hereby suspended from 11 January 2022 until further notice.

However, the Aeromedical Section of the OFSAM will still accept and process complete application for the initial issuance and/or renewal of Aviation Medical Certificates (Class 1, 2, and 3).

Moreover, Aviation Medical Certificates expiring on or after 11 January 2022 may request for an extension through email at aeromedical@caap.gov.ph.
