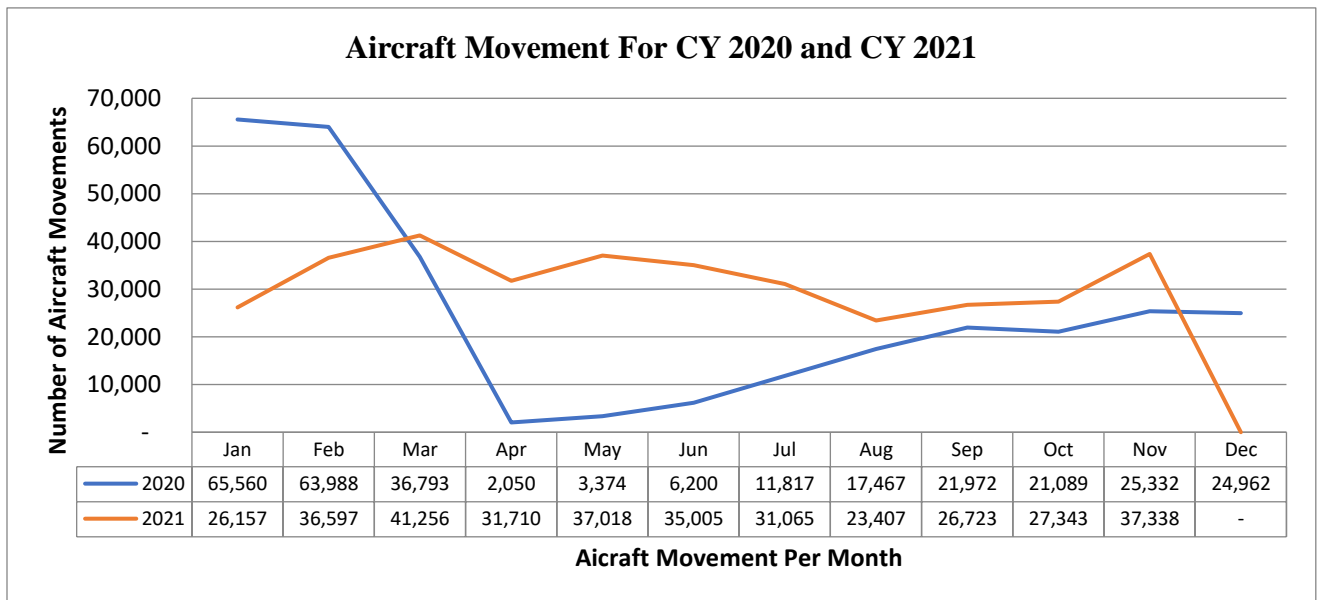

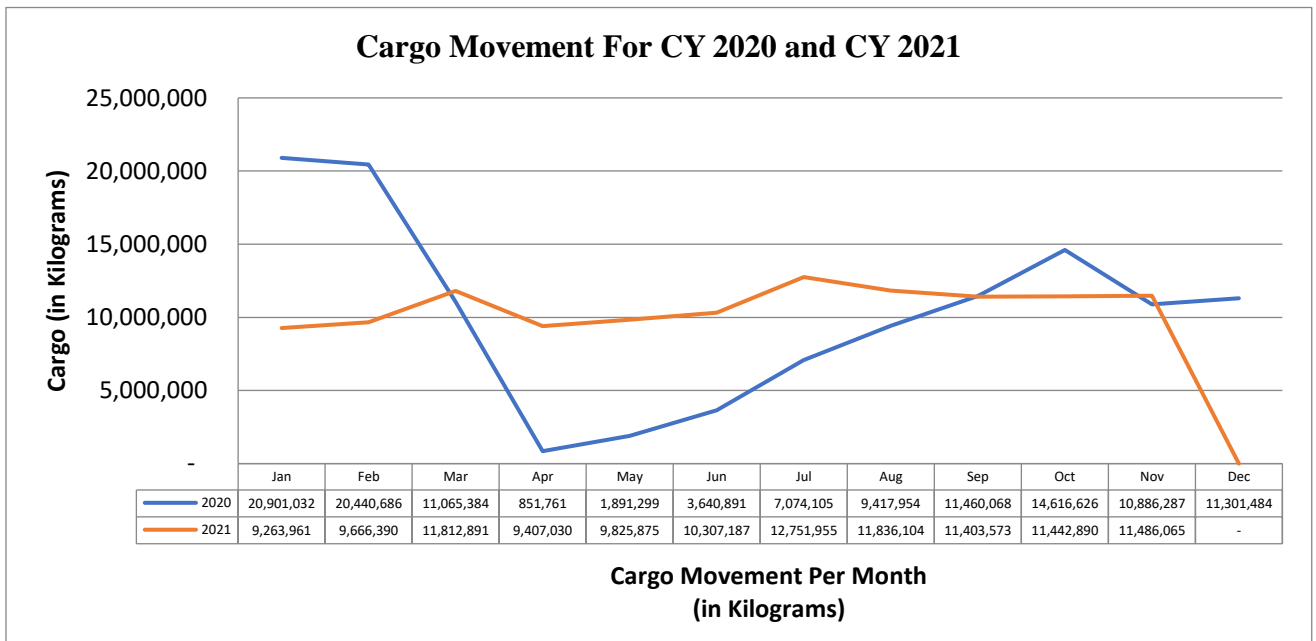
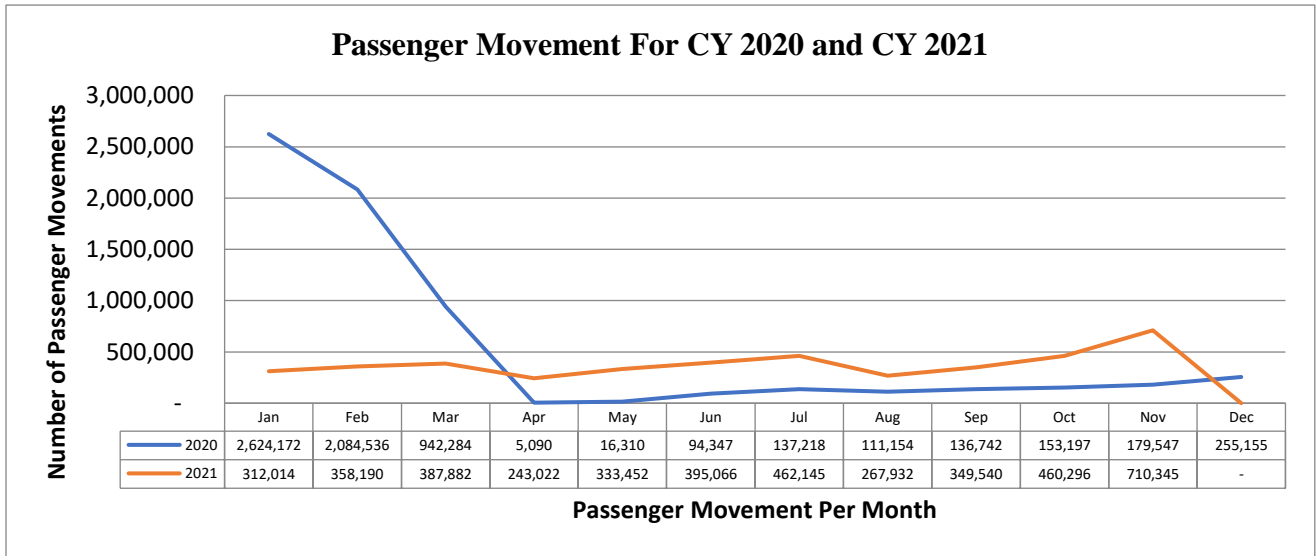

B. Comparison of Aircraft, Passenger, Cargo Movements in the CAAP Operated Airports for 2020-2021

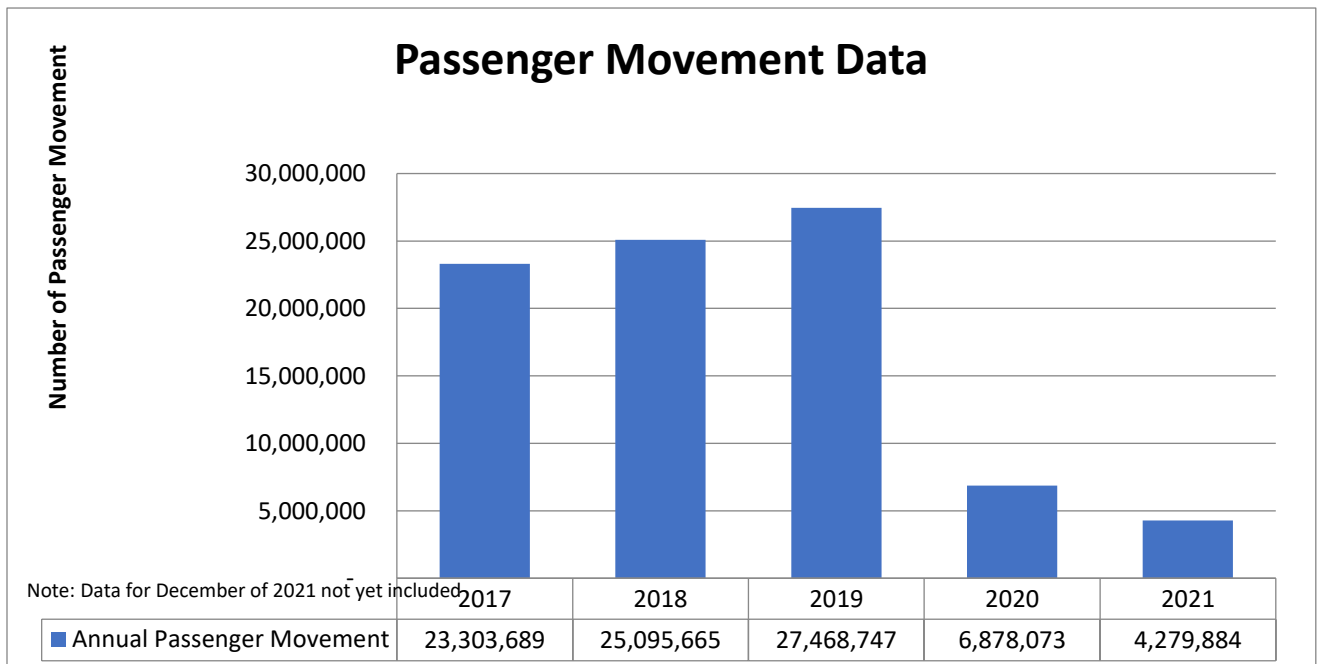
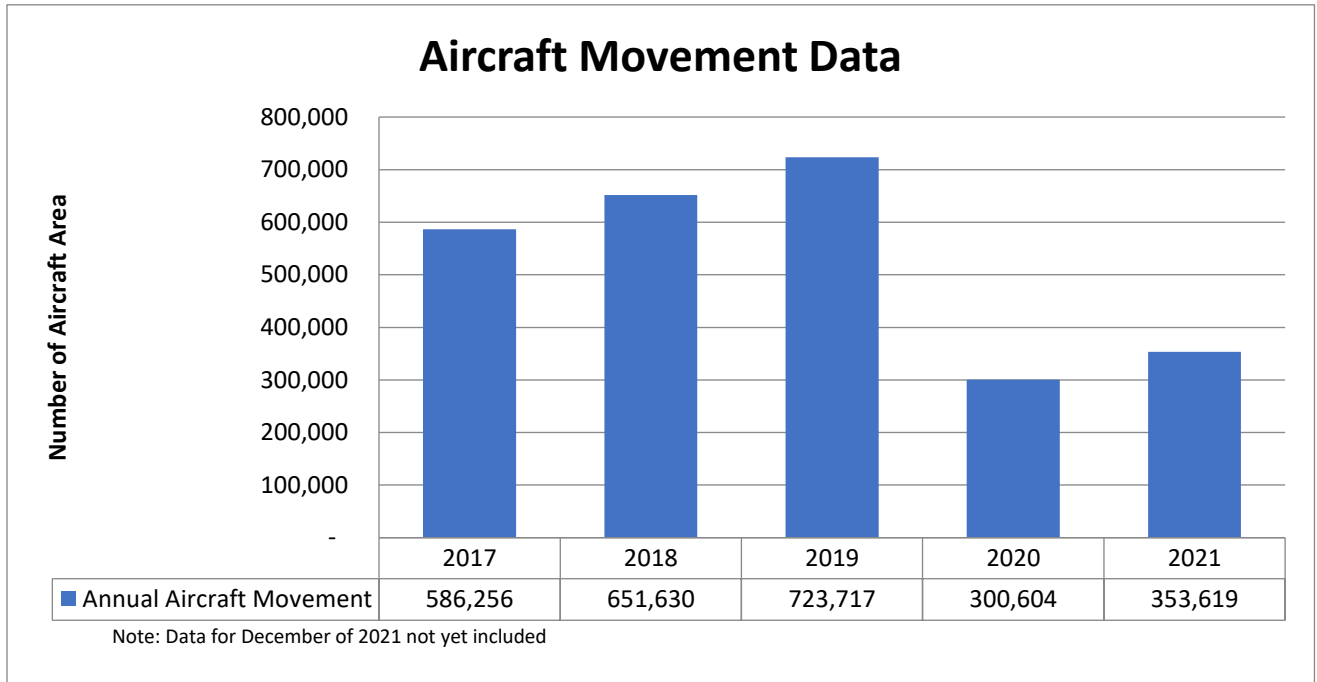


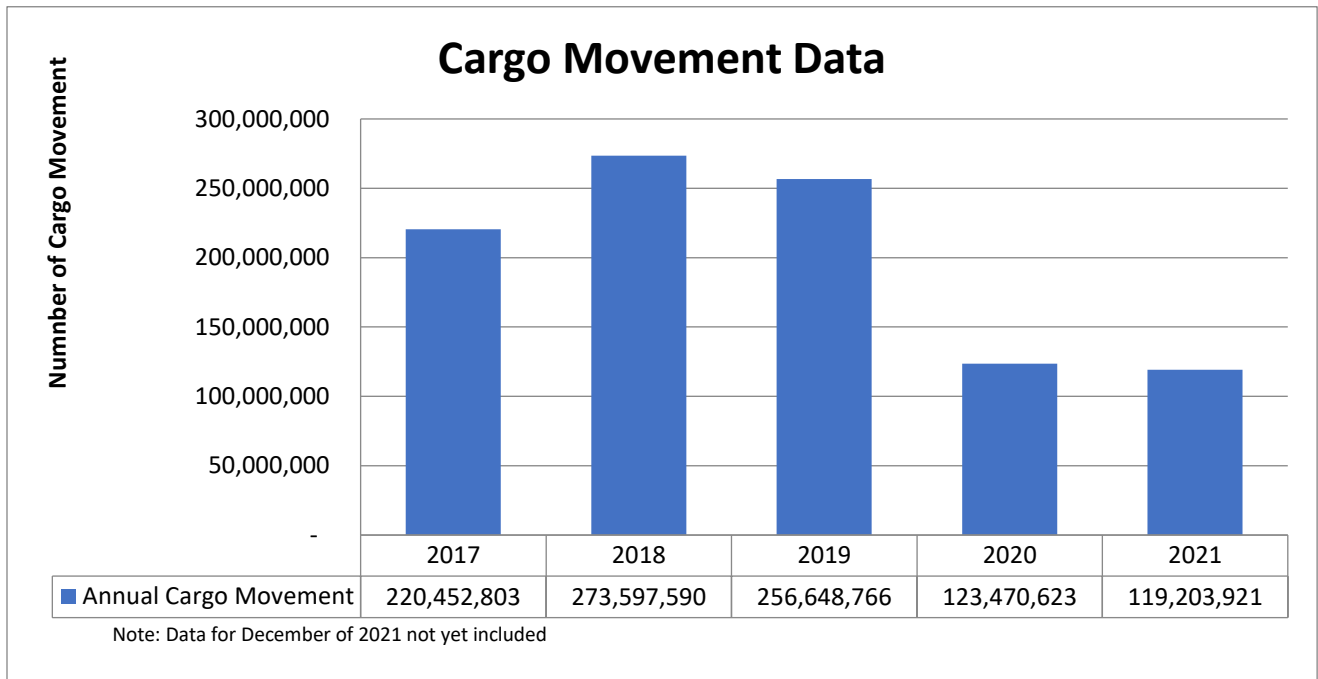


Based on the above graphs, with the easing of community quarantines and slowly opening the economy; aircraft, passenger and cargo movement had stabilized for the year 2021 averaging of 32,147 aircrafts, 389,080 passengers and 10,836,720 kilograms of cargoes per month for 11 months.



C. Five (5)-Year Comparison of Aircraft, Passenger, Cargo Movements in the CAAP Operated Airports

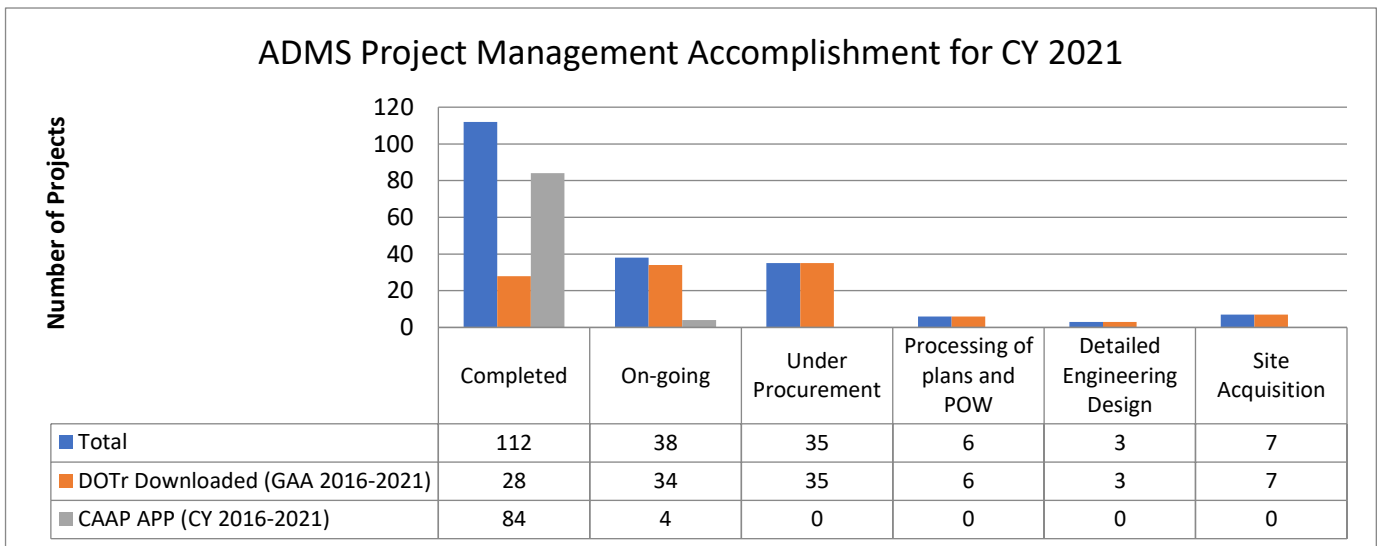
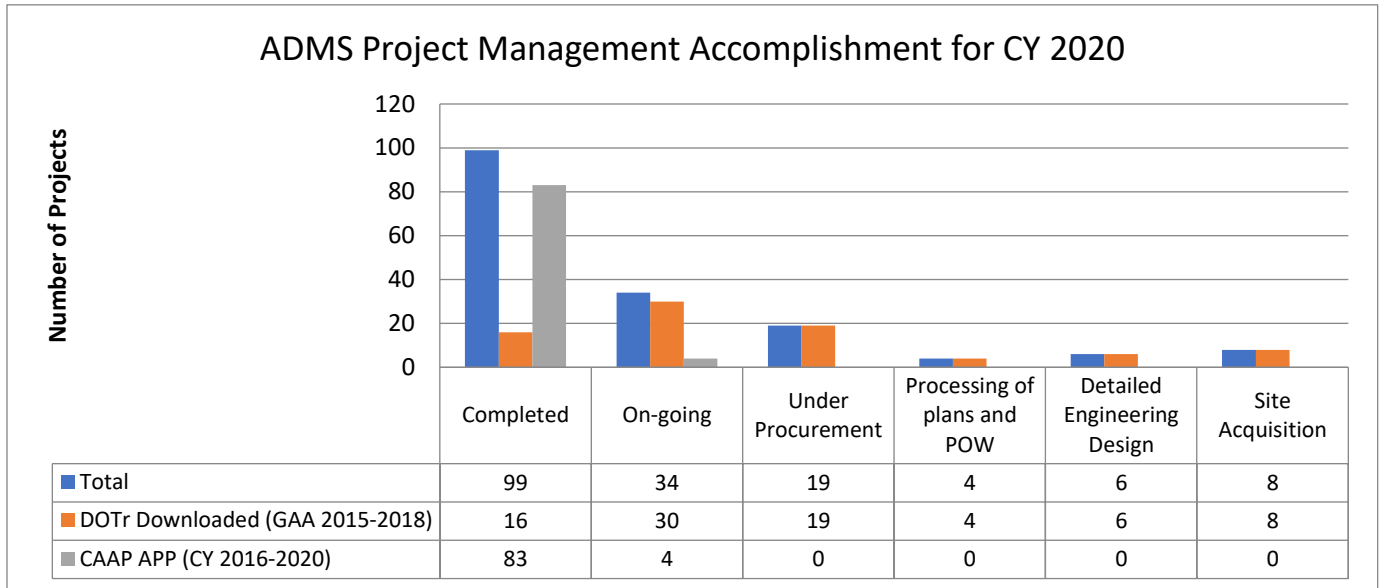




Though, roll-out of vaccination program and easing of community quarantines; still, the data shows the significant effect COVID-19 in the aviation industry.

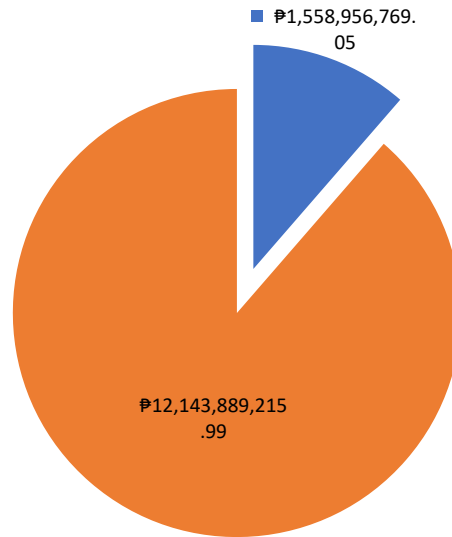

Even with the continued outbreak of the COVID-19 pandemic, CAAP was still able to complete twelve (12) projects from the DOTr Downloaded and one (1) from CAAP APP.

V. Other Agency Accomplishments

A. Actions/Response to Covid-19

1. Establishment and capacitation of CAAP Designated COVID-19 Safety Officers in various CAAP offices.
2. Daily monitoring and reporting of COVID-19 cases including contact tracing of close contacts in the workplace.
3. Establishment of CAAP COVID-19 Vaccination Task Force and coordination with LGU on the A4 Vaccination Rollout with 98% Vaccination Rate of the workforce.
4. Coordination with TRAZE App service provider on improving the contact tracing capacity and use as screening tool including data gathering and reporting.
5. Purchase of COVID-19 Kits for COVID-19 positive cases needing immediate medical support at home.
6. Established CAAP COVID-19 Vaccination Task Force tasked to facilitate planning and monitoring of CAAP employees vaccination.
7. Established coordination with Pasay LGU on the A4 Vaccination Rollout of CAAP Head Office employees.
8. Coordination with TRAZE App service provider on improving the contact tracing capacity and use as screening tool and for data gathering.
9. Continuous capacitation of Designated COVID-19 Safety Officers of various offices by Occupational Health Section.
10. Continuous monitoring and reporting of COVID-19 cases including active contact tracing in the workplace of reported cases.
11. Continuous implementation of Traze Application at CAAP Entrance Gate.
12. Monitoring of COVID-19 Vaccination Roll out for CAAP employees.
13. Provision of shuttle service to CAAP Personnel in Central Office.
14. Disinfection of all offices at CAAP Central Office every after office hours.
15. Provision of service to transport all scheduled personnel for vaccination.

B. Employment Generation Program

The Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines (CAAP) employs a total of six thousand eight hundred seventy (6,870) personnel in various airports and facilities nationwide as of December 2021. Despite the pandemic, CAAP and DOTr continuously ventures to open more airports, which will generate employment and help improve socio-economic conditions of the area.

VI. Feature Programs/Projects

A. Commencement of CNS-ATM Operations

The new Communications, Navigation, Surveillance / Air Traffic Management (CNS/ATM) system, which was inaugurated by President Rodrigo Duterte on January 16, 2018, is a project launched to upgrade the country's aviation technology, further develop aviation safety, optimize the airspace, reduce CO2 emissions, and promote greener skies. It also provides various computer-aided safety measures in Air Traffic Control (ATC) and enhances safety through reduction of controller/pilot workloads and human errors. With the integration, the country's air transport industry will benefit from increased airspace flexibility, optimal air traffic personnel workload delegation, safer air traffic service provision, and better overall efficiency of the country's aviation sector. Through the project, the country now has 13 radars (NAIA1, Clark, Tagaytay, Aparri, Laoag, Cebu-Mt. Majic, Quezon-Palawan, Zamboanga, NAIA2, Mactan, Bacolod, Kalibo, and Davao) covering around 70% of Philippine air space. Meanwhile, with the introduction of the Automatic Dependent Surveillance – Contract (ADS-C) and the Controller-Pilot Data Link Communications (CPDLC), the CNS/ATM will be able to cover 100% of the remaining oceanic airspace, hence increasing air traffic safety and capacity in the oceanic region of the Manila FIR.





B. Bohol-Panglao International Airport

Hailed as the “Green Gateway to the World,” Bohol-Panglao International Airport, which was inaugurated by President Rodrigo Duterte on November 27, 2018, functions on environmentally sustainable structures and green technology to the highest international standards. Located on Panglao Island in the province of Bohol, the airport can accommodate as many as two million passengers annually, more than double the 800,000 yearly capacity of Tagbilaran Airport, which BPIA replaced after its inauguration. As the country’s first “eco-airport,” the BPIA primarily utilizes natural ventilation. It also harnesses solar energy from panels installed on the roof of the Passenger Terminal Building (PTB), which will cover around 30% of the airport’s electrical requirements including the hot water supply system. Progress for the completion of the BPIA went on for 18 years, starting with its first Feasibility Study in 2000.
