The **CIVIL AVIATION AUTHORITY OF THE PHILIPPINES** will hold a **Pre-Bid Conference** on **JUNE 23, 2022 at 1:30 PM (for Rehabilitation of PTB) AND on JUNE 24, 2022 at 10:00 AM (Comprehensive Pest Control)** both **via ONLINE (GOOGLE MEET) and Face to Face** which shall be open to all prospective bidders. With this, the attendees may choose between two options for the attendance. Those who will attend personally, are advised to proceed at the **BAC Area XI Conference Room, Central Plant Bldg., Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines, Davao International Airport, Daang Maharlika Highway, Buhangin, Davao City**. All Bids must be accompanied by a bid security in any of the acceptable forms and in the amount stated in ITB Clause 18.

**IMPORTANT NOTE: Late bids shall not be accepted.**

**Bid opening for Rehabilitation of Passenger Terminal Building shall be on JULY 5, 2022 1:30 PM. For the Comprehensive Pest Control, the bid opening shall be on JULY 6, 2022 at 1:30 PM at the BAC Area XI Conference Room, Central Plant Bldg., Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines, Davao International Airport, Daang Maharlika Highway, Buhangin, Davao City.** Bids will be opened in front of or in the virtual presence of the bidders' representatives.

For the Public Bidding of the Infrastructure project, bidders must at least be licensed by the PCAB with Small B Category D registration, in accordance with the provisions of R.A. 4566 (2016 IRR Section 23.4.2.3)
