- I. Attention is hereby invited to the Bidders of SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF 46 UNITS 24R21 FIRE TRUCKS TIRES FOR VARIOUS AIRPORTS BID NO. 22-014-06 BRAVO.
- II. Please be informed of the following issues/clarifications:

	Issues/Queries	Clarification/s
a.	confirm if you consider the 24 R21 Fire Truck tires as Expendable or non-expendable supply.	1. ARFF considers Fire Truck Tires as non-expendable supplies since goods amounting to Php 50,000.00 and above are considered as Property, Plant and Equipment based on COA Circular No. 2022-004 dated 31 May 2022.  This is consistent with the SLCC requirement indicated in Section 5.3(a) of the PBD.
2.	With reference to Terms of Reference  a. Bidder's Eligibility i. Bidders must have a track record on 24R21 Fire Truck Tire sales?  - How will the BAC confirm that the bidder has a track record on 24R21 Fire Truck Tire sales?  - We humbly suggest as part of the eligibility requirement, prospective bidders must submit Certificate of Distributorship of the brand of tire being offered and show proof of previous delivery of 24R21 Fire Truck Tire sales by attaching Purchase Order/s, Invoices,	2. Bidder will be evaluated on their good standing and if they possess the experience in projects similar to the said project. Said item in the Terms of Reference was clarified in Bid Bulletin No. 02 dated 14 July 2022.

b. Similar Completed contracts - Since your requirement and as per project title is Supply and Delivery of 46 units 24R2l Fire Truck Tires for Various Airports, is it right to confirm that we shall only submit completed contracts that are similar to the project title, which are contract of tires for fire trucks for airports?	For this project, as stated in ITB Clause 5.3, contracts similar to the project shall be "Supply/Delivery of Heavy Equipment Tires". Not particularly airport fire truck tires.
3. In Section VI. Schedule of requirements - Total quantity of tires is 46 units, the distribution is 2 tires per airport. Please note that there are only 22 airports listed on the description. Please confirm the delivery site of the last two (2) tires.	3. Delivery site for the last two (2) tires is <b>DUMAGUETE AIRPORT.</b>
