The Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines (CAAP-Main Office), through its Canvass and Contract Committee (CCC), will undertake a Small Value Procurement for the "**Rehabilitation of the Voice and Data Cabling works for various Offices": DDG-A, HRMD/CRAD, RSD and ATS (3rd Floor) Warranty and Support** in accordance with Section 53.9 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184.

Interested suppliers are required to submit their valid and current following documents in a sealed envelope:

1. Mayor's or Business Permit issued by the city or municipality where the principal place of business of the prospective bidder is located, or the equivalent document for Exclusive Economic Zones or Areas;
2. Income/Business Tax Return for ABC's above P500,000.00;
3. PHILGEPS Registration Number;
4. Tax Clearance;
5. Notarized Omnibus Sworn Statement (GPPB prescribed Form) for ABC's above P50,000; (Authorized representative must attach Special Power of Attorney (SPA) for Sole Proprietorship Certificate/Secretary Certificate for Corporation)
6. Price quotation from (Annex "A") during submission of offer/Quotation and,
7. Brochure if applicable

Price quotation/s must be valid for a period of **one hundred twenty (120)** calendar days from the date of submission.

Quotations exceeding the Approved Budget for the Contract shall be rejected.

Award of contract shall be made to the lowest quotation, which complies with the minimum description as stated above and other terms and conditions stated in the price quotation form. In case two or more bidders are determined to have submitted the Lowest Calculated/Lowest Calculated and Responsive Quotation, CAAP-CCC shall adopt and employ "draw lots" as the tie breaking method to finally determine the single winning provider in accordance with GPPB Circular 06-2005.

The CAAP-TIAC shall have the right to inspect and/or test the goods to confirm their conformity to the technical specifications.

Any interlineations, erasures or overwriting shall be valid only if they are signed or initialed by the bidder or his/her duly authorized representative/s.

Liquidated damages equivalent to one tenth of one percent (0.1%) of the value of the goods not delivered within the prescribed delivery period shall be imposed per day of delay. CAAP shall rescind the contract once the cumulative amount of liquidated damaged reaches ten percent (10%) of the amount of the contract, without prejudice to other courses of action and remedies open to it.

OVERVIEW:

- CAAP old network infrastructure was commissioned 2015
- Has no maintenance/service level agreement after 2018.
- Several input/output ports damaged and unserviceable
- With the current pandemic situation, requirement for internet connectivity surpassed the existing number of input/output ports
- Persistent and frequent technical issues arise resulting from lack of maintenance, technical support and damages caused by pests and relocation.

Objective:

- To provide reliable and efficient network connectivity to CAAP employees
- Improve personnel and business productivity
- To achieve minimal downtime (99.99% up-time)
