



REQUEST FOR QUOTATION

The Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines (CAAP-Main Office), through its Canvass and Contract Committee (CCC), will undertake a Small Value Procurement for the “Post construction termite treatment services at CNS-ATM Compound, CAAP Central Office” in accordance with Section 53.9 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184.

Interested suppliers are required to submit their valid and current following documents in a sealed envelope:

1. Mayor’s or Business Permit issued by the city or municipality where the principal place of business of the prospective bidder is located, or the equivalent document for Exclusive Economic Zones or Areas;
2. Income/Business Tax Return for ABC’s above P500,000.00;
3. PHILGEPS Registration Number;
4. Tax Clearance;
5. Notarized Omnibus Sworn Statement (GPPB prescribed Form) for ABC’s above P50,000; (Authorized representative must attach Special Power of Attorney (SPA) for Sole Proprietorship Certificate/Secretary Certificate for Corporation)
6. Price quotation from (Annex “A”) during submission of offer/Quotation and,
7. Brochure

Price quotation/s must be valid for a period of **one hundred twenty (120)** calendar days from the date of submission.

Quotations exceeding the Approved Budget for the Contract shall be rejected.

Award of contract shall be made to the lowest quotation, which complies with the minimum description as stated above and other terms and conditions stated in the price quotation form. In case two or, more bidders are determined to have submitted the Lowest Calculated/Lowest Calculated and Responsive Quotation, CAAP-CCC shall adopt and employ “draw lots” as the tie breaking method to finally determine the single winning provider in accordance with GPPB Circular 06-2005.

The CAAP-TIAC shall have the right to inspect and/or test the goods to confirm their conformity to the technical specifications.

Any interlineations, erasures or overwriting shall be valid only if they are signed or initialed by the bidder or his/her duly authorized representative/s.

Liquidated damages equivalent to one tenth of one percent (0.1%) of the value of the goods not delivered within the prescribed delivery period shall be imposed per day of delay. CAAP shall rescind the contract once the cumulative amount of liquidated damaged reaches ten percent (10%) of the amount of the contract, without prejudice to other courses of action and remedies open to it.

Name of Project : POST CONSTRUCTION TERMITE TREATMENT SERVICE AT CNS-ATM COMPOUND, CAAP CENTRAL OFFICE

Location : CAAP Complex, Old Mia Road, Pasay City

SCOPE OF WORK

The Project covers the supply of labor, tools/equipment and supervision from a duly registered and licensed Pest Control Operator that offers complete, modern and comprehensive service for the control, treatment and prevention of subterranean termites on selected CAAP Buildings/Areas with warranty period and with the following scope of works to wit:

1. General survey and thorough inspection of the whole premises to determine the following:
 - a. *presence or absence of an infestation*
 - b. *location of the termite colony/ies*
 - c. *source or cause of the infestation*
 - d. *extent of damage to your property.*
 - e. *necessary measures to eradicate the infestation*
2. Demolition and extermination of discovered termite colony/ies
3. Application of Sub-Slab Termicide solution along all existing walls inside the ground floor to create an effective barrier. Spacing between drilled holes varies from 12" to 24" depending on the soil type and moisture. If necessary, holes are drilled on one side of partition walls and on both sides of load bearing walls. Holes are drilled 1/2" to 3/4" in diameter in the slab and deep enough to penetrate the slab.
4. Application of Pest-a-Spray for the control of termites, residual spraying through the use of a synthetic insecticide shall be carried out in the premises. This residual insecticide will provide long lasting control and continue to act for several days, weeks or months. This spraying also has flushing effect. Application, using a B & G Professional Sprayer, will be on places and area where termites congregate, crawl and hide or through cracks and crevices from which they may enter.
5. Above Ground Bait;

Like isoptex, Above Ground also Works by eliminating the entire termite colony.

 - Hexaflumuron, the active ingredient in the Senctricon System, is used in small quantities only when and where it is needed.
 - Above Ground Bait is approved by the Fertilizer and Pesticide Authority (FPA), and is the recipient of the U.S Presidential Green Chemistry Challenge Award from EPA.
