MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 015-2022

TO : ALL AIRCRAFT OWNERS, APPROVED TRAINING ORGANIZATION CERTIFICATE (FLYING SCHOOLS) AND AIR OPERATOR CERTIFICATE HOLDERS

SUBJECT : REGISTRATION OF AIRCRAFT CONVEYANCES

DATE : 24 MARCH 2022

It has come to the attention of the Authority that several aircraft conveyances are not annotated in the Certificate of Registration while the aircraft is being utilized in flight operations. Section 49 of the Republic Act No. 9497 provides;

SECTION 49. Conveyance to be Recorded. — No conveyance made or executed, which affects the title to, or interest in, any aircraft of Philippine registry, or any portion thereof shall be valid in respect to such aircraft or portion thereof against any person other than the person by whom the conveyance is made or executed, his heirs, assignees, executors, administrators, devisees, or successors in interest, and any person having actual notice thereof, until such conveyance is recorded in the Authority. Every such conveyance so recorded shall be valid as against all persons. Any instrument, recording of which is required by the provisions of this Act, shall take effect from the date of its record in the books of the Authority, and not from the date of its execution.

Be it noted that unrecorded aircraft conveyances with the Authority are not enforceable against third persons other than persons by whom the conveyances are made or executed except as provided in the above stated law.


In view of the foregoing, all aircraft owners, air operators and approved training organizations are encouraged to apply for the recording of aircraft conveyances with the Aircraft Registration Section of the Airworthiness Department.
