SUBJECT : EXTENDING THE VALIDITY OF CAAP ISSUED AIRMEN

LICENSES AND CERTIFICATES

DATE: 20 JANUARY 2022

In light of the temporary suspension of all on-site transactions in the Flight Standards Inspectorate Service (FSIS), the Licensing and Certification Department has implemented a limited onsite reporting workforce. In effect, the processing of applications of various licenses and certificates has been interrupted.

In view of this, to avoid untoward disruption of air operations, the validity of the following licenses and certificates expiring on or after 18 January 2022 is hereby extended to 18 February 2022:

Airline Transport Pilot License (ATPL)

Airline Transport Pilot License Helicopter (ATPLH)

Commercial Pilot License Helicopter (CPLH)

Commercial Pilot License (CPL)

Flight Engineer License (FEL)

Flight Instructor License (FIL)

Flight Operations Officer License (FOO)

Ground Instructor License (GI)

Multi-Crew Pilot License (MCPL)

Private Pilot License Helicopter (PPLH)

Private Pilot License (PPL)

Student Pilot Authorization (SPA)

Student Pilot Authorization Helicopter (SPAH)

Aircraft Mechanic Technician License (AMT)

Aviation Maintenance Specialist License (AMS)

Aeronautical Station Operator License (ASO)

Air Traffic Controller License (ATC)

Air Traffic Safety Electronic Personnel License (ATSEP)

Remotely Piloted Aircraft Controller Certificate

English Language Proficiency Certificate

Receiving of applications for initial issuance and/or renewal of the aforementioned certificates/licenses is temporarily suspended. However, pending applications for airmen licenses and certification before the Authority will be processed accordingly.

This Memorandum Circular shall take effect immediately.
