The International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) continuously develops and establishes measures, procedures, Standards and Recommended Practices (SARPS) to assist Contracting States in addressing the impact of COVID-19 Pandemic particularly in air transport safety. These measures are aimed to support continued safe operations while cautiously returning towards normal operations.

In view of this, in the interest of aviation safety, all air operators are hereby directed to review existing safety measures and operational procedures and shall make necessary revisions to ensure compliance with the latest ICAO SARPS particularly on the following:


1. Flight and Cabin Crew training requirements;
2. Continued Airworthiness and Maintenance of Aircraft;
3. Safe Transportation of Dangerous Goods by Air; and
4. Safety Management System

The revised safety measures and operational procedures shall be submitted to the Authority for approval. Resources on the latest ICAO safety issuances are available in the ICAO website at <https://www.icao.int/safety>.

The FSIS will closely monitor the implementation of this Memorandum Circular and conduct thorough audit inspection on the compliance of the Air Operators.

This Memorandum Circular shall take effect immediately.
