



Invitation to Bid for

CONSTRUCTION OF NEW PASSENGER TERMINAL BUILDING (PHASE I) AT OZAMIZ AIRPORT Bid No. 21-019-09 CHARLIE

1. The Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines through the GAA CY 2017 DOTr Downloaded Projects intends to apply the sum of **TWO HUNDRED TWENTY-TWO MILLION TWENTY-THREE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED THIRTY-FIVE PESOS 37/100 (PHP 222,023,935.37)** being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for **CONSTRUCTION OF NEW PASSENGER TERMINAL BUILDING (PHASE I) AT OZAMIZ AIRPORT (Bid No. 21-019-09 CHARLIE)**. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at bid opening.
2. The Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines now invites bids for the above Procurement Project.

Completion of the Works is required **Five Hundred Seventy (570) Calendar Days (inclusive of 43 rainy/unworkable days)**. Bidders should have completed a contract similar to the Project. The description of an eligible bidder is contained in the Bidding Documents, particularly, in Section II (Instructions to Bidders).

3. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using non-discretionary “*pass/fail*” criterion as specified in the 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 9184.

Interested bidders may obtain further information from BAC Office, CAAP Compound, MIA Road corner Ninoy Aquino Avenue, 1300 Pasay City, Metro Manila on **September 08, 2021 until deadline of submission of bid** and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below from 08:00 AM to 05:00 PM from MONDAY to FRIDAY.
5. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by interested bidders **September 08, 2021 until deadline of submission of bid** from given address and website/s below and upon payment of the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents, pursuant to the latest Guidelines issued by the GPPB, in the amount of **Php 56,000.00 (inclusive of 12% VAT)**. The Procuring Entity shall allow the bidder to present its proof of payment for the fees by presenting the official receipt in person.
6. The Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines will hold a Pre-Bid Conference¹ on September 15, 2021 @ 2:00PM at CAAP Conference Room, CAAP Compound, MIA Road Ninoy Aquino Avenue, 1300 Pasay City, Metro and/or through videoconferencing/webcasting via Jitsi/Zoom/Google Meet, which shall be open to prospective bidders.
7. Bids must be duly received by the BAC Secretariat at the address below on or before **September 29, 2021 @ 2:00PM** at BAC Office, CAAP Compound, MIA Road corner Ninoy Aquino Avenue, 1300 Pasay City, Metro Manila. Late bids shall not be accepted.
8. All bids must be accompanied by a bid security in any of the acceptable forms and in the amount stated in **ITB** Clause 16.
9. Bid opening shall be on **September 29, 2021 @ 2:00PM** at the given address below and/or through Jitsi/Zoom/Google Meet. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders’ representatives who choose to attend the activity.
10. The Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines reserves the right to reject any and all bids, declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract at any time prior to contract award in accordance with Sections 35.6 and 41 of the 2016 revised Implementing Rules and
