

MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR 23-16

TO: ALL AOC HOLDERS, SHIPPERS, CARGO AGENCIES, FRIEGHT FORWARDERS, GROUND HANDLING SERVICE PROVIDERS, AMOs AND ATOS

Effective immediately, in the interest of public service and in response to the various grievances/complaints, the requirement of securing accreditation from the Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines (CAAP) by persons/entities engaged in the shipment of Dangerous Goods by Air, as prescribed under Memorandum Circular 02-14 dated 10 January 2014, is temporarily suspended.

Accordingly, appropriate guidelines governing the safe carriage/shipment by air of Dangerous Goods shall be issued after the review and public consultation on the existing rules/regulations regarding the responsibilities of Air Operator Certificate (AOC) holders and the statutory oversight functions of this Authority regarding the matter.
