

Pursuant to the powers vested on the Director General of the Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines (CAAP) under Republic Act 9497 otherwise known as the Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines Act of 2008 and in the interest of aviation safety, **the Memorandum Circular No.: 02-14 dated 10 January 2014** which mandates all organizations or individuals involved in the process of shipping Dangerous Goods by Air to secure necessary accreditation from the CAAP before dealing or transacting with the AOCs authorized to carry Dangerous Goods is hereby **RESCINDED**.

**EFFECTIVITY:**

Fifteen (15) days after publication in a requisite single newspaper of general circulation and a copy filed with the U.P. Law Center – Office of the National Administrative Register (ONAR), this Memorandum Circular shall take effect and supersedes any orders and/or memoranda in conflict herewith.
