MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 024-2022

TO : ALL AIR OPERATORS CONDUCTING LOCAL AND INTERNATIONAL AIR OPERATIONS

SUBJECT : HEALTH AND SAFETY PROTOCOLS FOR FLIGHT AND CABIN CREW MEMBERS

DATE : 06 SEPTEMBER 2022

Effective immediately, the Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines will be implementing the following COVID-19 health and safety protocols for flight and cabin crew members:

- a) Flight and cabin crew members are no longer required to undergo the mandatory facility-based quarantine, but shall self-monitor for any signs and symptoms of COVID-19;
- b) Crew members experiencing COVID -19 symptoms shall immediately report to the air operator;
- c) Air operators shall provide medical assessment for flight and cabin crew members with possible COVID-19 infection in accordance with the evaluation and procedure implemented by the Philippine government;
- d) Air operator shall provide medical assistance for flight crew members who tested positive to COVID-19 during layover or in-transit; and
- e) For flight and cabin crew members who need to layover or transit at an outstation, air operator shall ensure strict compliance with the relevant public health regulations, policies, and established measures.

This Memorandum supersedes M.C. No. 06-2022 and M.C. No. 07-2022 and all Orders/Memoranda in conflict herewith are hereby rescinded.
