Subject : Non-Destructive Testing Requirements During Engine Overhaul

Date : 06 September 2023

In relation to the aforementioned matter, and in order to prevent any engine failure that may arise due to the deviation from the applicable procedures, all Approved Maintenance Organizations with Continental Motors and Lycoming overhaul capabilities are hereby reminded to adhere to the procedures prescribed under Continental Motors MSB96-10B and Lycoming Service Instruction No. 1285F, respectively. Additionally, adherence to other applicable Engine Overhaul and NDT Service Instructions, Bulletins, Information and/or guidance materials specific for other engine types and models is likewise enjoined.

Moreover, all affected AMOs are also directed to perform an internal audit regarding the above and to submit a comprehensive report not later than thirty (30) days from the day of receipt of this Memorandum.

Further, an on-site assessment at all affected AMO facilities will be scheduled to verify compliance with safety regulations and to determine the organization's capability to execute the subject maintenance.
