SUBJECT : AMENDMENT TO PHILIPPINE CIVIL AVIATION REGULATIONS PART 7

Pursuant to the powers vested on the Director General of the Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines under Republic Act No. 9497, otherwise known as the Civil Aviation Authority Act of 2008 and in accordance with the Regulations Amendment/Revision Procedure with Board Resolution No. 2012-054 dated 28 September 2012, I hereby approve the following amendment to the Philippine Civil Aviation Regulations Part 7.

AMENDED REGULATIONS:

**PHILIPPINE CIVIL AVIATION REGULATIONS PART 7
INSTRUMENT AND EQUIPMENT**

**7.3 COMMUNICATION AND SURVEILLANCE EQUIPMENT
7.3.1 RADIO EQUIPMENT**

(i) ~~[AAC] For flights in defined portions of airspace or on routes where a Required Communication Performance (RCP) type has been prescribed, operations where communication and/or surveillance equipment are required to meet an RCP and/or RSP specification for performance-based communication and surveillance (PBCS), in addition to 7.3.1(a) and (b) and 7.3.3, an aircraft shall:~~

- (1) ~~have installed~~ be provided with communication and/or surveillance equipment which will enable it to operate in accordance with the prescribed RCP and/or RSP specifications;
- (2) ~~be authorized by the State of the Operator for operations in such airspace.~~ have information relevant to the aircraft RCP and/or RSP specification capabilities listed in the flight manual or other aircraft documentation approved by the State of Design or State of Registry;

(3) have information relevant to the aircraft RCP and/or RSP specification capabilities included in the MEL; and

Note.- Information on the performance-based communication and surveillance (PBCS) concept and guidance material on its implementation are contained in the Performance-based Communication and Surveillance (PBCS) Manual (Doc 9869).

(4) be authorized by the Authority for operations in such airspace.

Note.- Information on the required elements for operations to be granted PBCS operational authorization by the Authority may be found in the ICAO "Operational Authorization Guidance for Performance-based Communication and Surveillance (PBCS)".

"End of Amendments"

Separability Clause - If, for any reason, any provision of this Memorandum Circular is declared invalid or unconstitutional, the other part or parts thereof which are not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.

Repealing Clause - All orders, rules, regulations and issuances, or parts thereof which are inconsistent with this Memorandum Circular are hereby repealed, superseded or modified accordingly.

Determination of Changes - To highlight the amendments and/or revisions in the Memorandum Circular, the deleted text shall be shown with strikethrough and the new inserted text shall be highlighted with grey shading, as illustrated below:

1. Text deleted: ~~Text to be deleted is shown with a line through it.~~

3. New text replacing existing text: ~~Text to be deleted is shown with a line through it~~ followed by the replacement text which is highlighted with grey shading.

Effectivity - Fifteen (15) days after compliance with the requisite publication in a single newspaper of general circulation and a copy filed with the U.P. Law Center – Office of the National Administrative Register.
