



**REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR
PROCUREMENT OF CONSULTANCY SERVICE FOR THE CONDUCT
OF DETAILED ENGINEERING DESIGN OF THE EXPANSION OF
PASSENGER TERMINAL BUILDING (PTB) AT DAVAO
INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT**

Bid No. 21-04-07 Bravo

1. The Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines, through the Department of Transportation (DOTr) Downloaded Infrastructure Projects intends to apply the sum of **Thirteen Million Six Hundred Thirty-Nine Thousand Two Hundred Pesos (Php 13,639,200.00)**, being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for **Consultancy Service for the conduct of Detailed Engineering Design of the Expansion of Passenger Terminal Building (PTB) at Davao International Airport (Bid No. 21-04-07 Bravo)**. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at the opening of the financial proposals.
2. The CAAP now calls for the submission of eligibility documents for **Consultancy Service for the conduct of Detailed Engineering Design of the Expansion of Passenger Terminal Building (PTB) at Davao International Airport**. Eligibility documents of interested consultants must be duly received by the BAC Secretariat on or before **2:00 P.M., 10 August 2021** at BAC Office, CAAP Compound, MIA Road corner Ninoy Aquino Avenue, 1300 Pasay City, Metro Manila. Applications for eligibility will be evaluated based on a non-discretionary “pass/fail” criterion.
3. Interested bidders may obtain further information from BAC Office, CAAP Compound, MIA Road corner Ninoy Aquino Avenue, 1300 Pasay City, Metro Manila on **14 July 2021** and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below during 08:00 AM to 05:00 PM from MONDAY to FRIDAY.
4. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by interested bidders on **14 July 2021** from the address below and upon payment of the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents, pursuant to the latest Guidelines issued by the GPPB, in the amount of **Php 28,000.00 (inclusive of 12% VAT)**.

It may also be downloaded free of charge from the website of the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) and the website of the Procuring Entity, provided that Bidders shall pay the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents not later than the submission of their bids.

5. The BAC shall draw up the short list of consultants from those who have submitted Expression of Interest, including the eligibility documents, and have been determined as eligible in accordance with the provisions of Republic Act 9184 (RA 9184), otherwise

known as the “Government Procurement Reform Act”, and its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR).

The short list shall consist of five (5) prospective bidders who will be entitled to submit bids. The criteria and rating system for short listing are:

“Applicable Experience” pertains to the Bidder and associates in case of joint ventures, considering both the overall experiences of the firm and the individual experiences of the principal and key staff including the times when employed by other Consultants;

“Qualification of Personnel” pertains to the personnel who may be assigned to the job vis-à-vis extent and complexity of the undertaking;

“Current Workload” means the absorptive capacity of the Applicant to do additional works other than those currently undertaken.

These are added to determine the total points for the Applicant. The Applicants shall then be ranked according to their “Total Points” and the top five (5) shall be considered as the short list and qualify them to bid for the contemplated contract. **Should less than the required number apply for eligibility and short listing, pass the eligibility check, and/or pass the minimum score required in the short listing, the BAC shall consider the same.** Further, applicants must collect a minimum score of “seventy (70) points” to qualify for short listing.

6. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion as specified in the IRR of RA 9184.

Bidding is open to all interested bidders, whether local or foreign, subject to the conditions for eligibility provided in the IRR of RA 9184.

7. The CAAP shall evaluate bids using the **Quality Cost Based Evaluation/Selection (QCBE/QCBS)** procedure. The technical and financial proposals shall be given weights at eighty percent (80%) and twenty percent (20%), respectively, for a total of one hundred percent (100%).

8. The contract shall be completed within **Two Hundred Ten (210) Calendar Days**.

9. The CAAP reserves the right to reject any and all bids, declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract at any time prior to contract award in accordance with Section 41 of RA 9184 and its IRR, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
