The Government Republic of the Philippines, through the CIVIL AVIATION AUHORITY OF THE PHILIPPINES, Iloilo International Airport represented herein by ENGR. EUSEBIO F. MONSERATE JR., in his capacity as Acting Area Manager, Area Center VI, duly authorized for this purpose, with office address at Iloilo International Airport, Brgy. Gaub, Cabatuan, Iloilo, hereinafter referred to as the "PROCURING ENTITY";

-and-

EAJ CONSTRUCTION AND SUPPLY a Company, duly organized and existing by virtue of Laws of the Republic of the Philippines with office address at No.9 Sto. Rosario St., Iloilo City, represented by ENA GLIDE B. LIM, Authorized Representative as PARTY OF THE SECOND PARTY, hereinafter referred to as the "CONTRACTOR" Who has been duly authorized for its purpose;

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, in accordance with the advertisement of the PROCURING ENTITY published/posted in accordance with the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of RA 9184, the CONTRACTOR & other contractors/bidders submitted bids to the RENOVATION AND UPGRADING OF COMFORT ROOMS AT PTB OF ILOILO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT, in accordance with the plans & specifications & requirements thereof;

WHEREAS, the above-mentioned project, by the recommendation of the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) and stated on the approved Annual Procurement Plan for 2023, which was approved by the Head of the Procuring Entity, has been considered thru Public/Competitive Bidding;

WHEREAS, after the opening of bids on last October 4, 2023, the bid price of the CONTRACTOR was found to be the Single Calculated Responsive Bid;

WHEREAS, under Resolution No. <u>CILO 2023-016-02</u> dated <u>October 4, 2023</u>, the BAC recommends the award to the EAJ CONSTRUCTION AND SUPPLY as the winning Bidder in

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the amount of Two Million Nine Hundred Nine Thousand Two Hundred Ninety Four Pesos & 88/100 (₱ 2,909,294.88).

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, and covenants hereinafter set forth, the parties hereto have agreed as follows:

- 1. That PROCURING ENTITY and CONTRACTOR shall abide by the provisions and specifications stated on the following documents, which shall be included in this Contract (whichever is applicable):
 - a. Invitation to Bid or Request For Quotation, if any;
 - b. Drawing/Plans
 - c. Specifications
 - d. Eligibility Requirements:
 - d.1. Registration Certificate from SEC, DTI for Sole proprietorship, CDA for cooperatives
 - d.2. Mayor's Permit/Business Permit
 - d.3. Statement of all On-going & Completed Government & Private Contracts
 - d.4. Latest Audited Financial Statements Stamped Received by BIR
 - d.5. Annual Income Tax Return
 - d.6. Omnibus Sworn Statement in accordance with Section 25.2 (b.) (iv) of the Revised IRR of R.A. 9184
 - e. Bid Bulletin, if any;
 - f. Notice of Award of Contract and Contractor's "Conforme" thereto;
 - g. Purchase Order or Notice to Proceed, whichever is applicable;
 - h. Other contract documents that may be required by existing laws and / or the agency concerned.
- 2. The PROCURING ENTITY and the CONTRACTOR hereby agrees that the SCOPE OF WORK shall be the RENOVATION AND UPGRADING OF COMFORT ROOMS AT PTB OF ILOILO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT;
- 3. That PROCURING ENTITY shall pay the CONTRACTOR upon the former's satisfaction in the total amount of Two Million Nine Hundred Nine Thousand Two Hundred Ninety Four Pesos & 88/100 (P 2,909,294.88) in Philippine Currency. However, the CONTRACTOR may opt to collect at least fifty (50%) percent of the fee provided that they have accomplished at least fifty (50%) percent of the project per evaluation and satisfaction of the PROCURING ENTITY;
- 4. That in consideration of the payments to be made by the PROCURING ENTITY to the CONTRACTOR, the CONTRACTOR hereby covenants with the PROCURING ENTITY to execute and complete the WORKS and remedy any defects therein in conformity with the provision of this CONTRACT AGREEMENT in all respects;
- 5. That the CONTRACTOR will fully & faithfully furnish all required materials and/or labor and will complete the said contract for the RENOVATION AND UPGRADING OF COMFORT ROOMS AT PTB OF ILOILO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT and hereby agrees to complete the Contract within SIXTY (60) CALENDAR DAYS which shall commence on the date received by the Contractor of the Purchase Order or seven (7) days after upon the receipt of Notice to Proceed, whichever is applicable;

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6. The CONTRACTOR shall, at its proper cost and expense, fully and faithfully deliver the goods enumerated below:

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

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The CONTRACTOR shall furnish all the equipment, material and labor necessary for the aforementioned project to be completed in accordance with the provisions of the Revised IRR of RA 9184 and other related documents which are hereby made and incorporated in this contract;

- 7. The CONTRACTOR shall comply with the attach TERMS OF REFERENCE (see TOR).
- 8. The CONTRACTOR shall comply with, and strictly observe, all laws regarding workmen's health and safety, workmen's welfare, compensation for injuries, minimum wages, hours of labor and other labor laws, the other relevant and applicable provisions of the Labor Code of the Philippines included herein the submission of the names and profile of their manpower assigned to perform the task for credibility check to implement the project and to secure safety in the airport grounds;
- 9. No extension of time shall be granted to the CONTRACTOR due to ordinary unfavorable weather condition, non-availability of materials or equipment to be furnished or used by it, labor problems and such causes for which the PROCURING ENTITY is not directly responsible, or when time-affected activities do not fall within the critical path of the network. Extension of time shall be granted only for the equivalent period of delay due to major natural calamities such as earthquake, typhoon, and the likes, which will cause unworkable conditions as well as stoppage of work on orders of the PROCURING ENTITY;
- 10. The CONTRACTOR warrants that he has not given nor promised to give any money or gifts to any employee/official of the PROCURING ENTITY (or any Philippine Government Instrumentality/ies) to secure this CONTRACT;
- 11. The CONTRACTOR shall not assign, transfer, pledge, sub-contract or make such any other dispositions of the Contract or any part or interest therein except upon written notice to and prior approval of the PROCURING ENTITY. The approval of the sub-contract shall not relieve the CONTRACTOR from any liability or obligation under this Contract Agreement;
- 12. As a Warranty, within the period of at least one (1) year after the completion and final acceptance, the CONTRACTOR shall remain liable for any damages and defects discovered in the work due to faulty installation or the use of inferior materials. The PROCURING ENTITY shall retain the amount equivalent to one (1%) percent of the total project cost as Guarantee Bond or Warranty Deposit and shall be retained for the duration of its warranty.

The PROCURING ENTITY shall promptly notify the CONTRACTOR in writing of any claims arising under this warranty. Upon receipt of such notice, the CONTRACTOR shall, within the period specified in the SCC and with all reasonable speed, repair or replace the defective Goods or parts thereof, without cost to the PROCURING ENTITY.

That any violation of this Warranty shall constitute a sufficient ground for the rescission or cancellation of this Contract or the reduction of the Contract Price or the consideration paid without prejudice to the filing of civil criminal action under the Anti-Graft Law and other applicable laws against the CONTRACTOR and/or his representatives.

The CONTRACTOR shall render the PROCURING ENTITY free and harmless from any and/or all claim(s) or action(s) which may now hereafter be filed by any third person by reason of the foregoing;

13. The provisions of R.A. 9184 and its Implementing Rules and Regulations Part A, as amended, on liquidated damages which shall be payable by the CONTRACTOR in case of breach thereof. The amount of liquidated damages shall be at least equal to one-tenth of one

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percent (0.1%) of the cost of the unperformed portion for everyday of delay. Once the cumulative amount of liquidated damages reaches ten percent (10%) of the amount of the contract, the PROCURING ENTITY shall rescind the contract, without prejudice to other courses of action and remedies open to it;

- 14. The PROCURING ENTITY reserve the right to unilaterally rescind/terminate/revoke this Contract even before its expiration whenever determined that the CONTRACTOR's accomplishment/performance is unsatisfactory, based on specifications and accomplishment report duly submitted/prepared by the PROCURING ENTITY's duly authorized representatives;
- 15. The parties hereby mutually agree that in case of court suit/litigation arising from this Contract, the same shall be filed with the court of appropriate jurisdiction within Iloilo City;
- 16. This contract/agreement becomes binding and valid upon the parties and shall remain effective upon approval hereof until the final completion and acceptance of the project.

TERMS OF REFERENCE

RENOVATION AND UPGRADING OF COMFORT ROOMS AT ILOILO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

I. GENERAL CONDITIONS:

1. Administrative Requirements:

The Contractor shall comply with the following:

- 1.1 Visit and inspect the site to apprise oneself of the actual condition that will affect the implementation of the project to be done. The Contractor shall secure a Certificate of Site Inspection from the Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines (CAAP).
- 1.2 Comply with the security, safety, Iloilo International Airport house rules, and plans for maintaining site cleanup.
- 1.3 Investigation and submission of report/s to Iloilo International Airport for any accident or untoward incident that may occur at the site for the duration of the project.
- 1.4 Assume all responsibility for injuries to persons and damages to Iloilo International Airport and other property caused by the execution of the works and shall be liable for any claims against Iloilo International Airport on account of such injury and/or damage.

2. Prohibitions:

- 2.1 Drinking of liquor, smoking and gambling in the building and the Contractor's storage area.
- 2.2 Cooking of any kind of food and eating in the project/work area.
- 2.3 Loitering in areas other than the project site.

3. Safety and Sanitation Requirements:

- 3.1 Workers engaged in the project shall wear appropriate personal protective equipment.
- 3.2 Employees of the Contractor shall wear uniform/T-shirts marked with the Contractor's company name and shall wear valid company I.D. while inside the Iloilo International Airport premises.
- 3.3 All areas affected by implementation of the project shall be thoroughly cleaned to the full satisfaction of the Iloilo International Airport.

4. Requirements for Storage of Equipment:

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- 4.1 All equipment shall be stacked in a stable and self-supporting manner. All sharp objects shall be removed to avoid mjury to workers and Bollo International Airport personnel.
- 4.2 Passageways and all access ways shall be kept free from equipment and material abstructions at all times.

III. SCOPE OF WORK:

The Communior shall provide all labor, materials, equipment, tools, technical supervision and expense for the Renovation and Upgrading Comfort Rooms at Bollo International Surport, Columna, Bollo.

L. Demolition Works

- 1.1 Desmanting of all toilet fintures and accessories such as water closet, urinals and auto faucets.
- 1.2 Chipping Removal of floor and wall tiles and lavatory counters of comfort mome at pre-departure and baggage claim only.
- 1.3 All the dismantied fixtures and its accessories shall be stored in the designated area assigned by the authorized representative of Boilo International Airport.
- 1.4 The Contractor shall provide the necessary protection to toilet fixtures and other equipment facility within the work area during the dismantling, demolition and installation to avoid damages.
- 1.5 The contractor can close and work simultaneously on toilets at pre-departure area and haggage claim. But in Pre-departure, the contractor must complete first the sets of toilets at the right side before they can start working at the left side.

2. Tile Works

- 2.1 Chipping remove existing wall and floor tiles but not damaging the water proofing of the floor and embedded pipes on walls.
- 2.2 Clean the area before the installation of new tiles.
- 13 Install the new floor and wall tiles and composite panels.
- 2.4 Installation of new levatory counters
- 2.5 All tile works must be done by a professional tile setter or with remarkable experience in tile installations.
- 2.6 The contractor must submit a request for inspection to the Engineering Unit for the following work activities
 - Materials Delivery Inspection
 - b. Preparation of the area prior to tile installation.
 - c. Tile setting prior to grouting.
 - d. Form works for lavatory counter installation prior to concreting
 - e. Lavatory granite counter igstallation

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- Preliminary Inspection (95% completed)/ Punch listing in preparation for the final inspection.
- 2.7 Work activities that were not inspected and without the approval of project incharge might be rejected.

3. Ceiling Works

- 3.1 Installation of drop ceiling as specified in layout.
- 3.2 Installation of laminated plywood on drop ceilings.
- 3.3 Repainting of existing ceilings
- 3.4 The contractor must submit a request for inspection to the Engineering Unit for the following work activities
 - a. Materials Delivery Inspection
 - b. Drop ceiling framing installation prior to installation of ceiling boards.
 - Ceiling board installation prior to the installation of laminated plywood.
 - d. Ceiling preparation prior to painting works.
 - e. Preliminary Inspection (95% completed)/ Punch listing in preparation for the final inspection.
- 3.5 Work activities that were not inspected and without the approval of project incharge might be rejected.

4. Electrical and Plumbing Works

- 4.1 Installation of additional downlight at drop ceilings which will be connected to the existing lighting circuit.
- 4.2 Installation electrical connection of auto faucets and urinals.
- 4.3 Installation of electrical connections of hand driers and mirrors.
- 4.4 The contractor must submit a request for inspection to the Engineering Unit for the following work activities
 - a. Materials Delivery Inspection
 - b. Electrical stub outs prior to tile setting
 - c. Megger testing of newly installed electrical wirings
 - d. Preliminary Inspection (95% completed)/ Punch listing in preparation for the final inspection.
- 4.5 Work activities that were not inspected and without the approval of project incharge might be rejected.

5. Installation of Toilet Fixtures

- 5.1 Installation of new lavatory, hand driers and auto faucets.
- 5.2 Reinstallation of water closets and its accessories.
- 5.3 Reinstallation of urinals and its accessories.

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- 5.4 The contractor must submit a request for inspection to the Engineering Unit for the following work activities
 - a. Materials Delivery Inspection
 - b. Toilet fixtures installation
 - Preliminary Inspection (95% completed)/ Punch listing in preparation for the final inspection.
- 5.5 Work activities that were not inspected and without the approval of project incharge might be rejected.

V. TERMS AND CONDITIONS

 The Contractor shall, within seven (7) calendar days after issuance of Notice to Proceed conduct a pre-construction meeting that will be attended by project in-charge, end user and contractor's representative.

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- The project shall be completed within sixty (60) calendar days from the effectivity date indicated in the Notice to Proceed.
- The Contractor represents and warrants that it has the capacity to perform its
 obligations and undertakings according to the terms and conditions of this project, and
 hereby agrees and warrants that it shall faithfully observe and comply therewith.
- 4. All works must be done without disruption on the working conditions of the airport.
- 5. The Contractor's Warranty shall be for a period of one (1) year after acceptance of the project. The warranty shall include the cost of parts and labor. During the warranty period, the Contractor must rectify any defects within three (3) days from time received of request from CAAP.
- 6. Payment will be made as follows:
 - a. 50% progress payment will be made after issuance by the CAAP of Certificate of 50% accomplishment and submission of all documents.
 - Full payment will be made after issuance by the CAAP of Certificate of Acceptance and submission of all documents.
 - All payments shall be subject to applicable taxes.
- The execution of all works shall be subject to the inspection and acceptance by the CAAP authorized representatives.

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
