#### **ORIGINAL REGULATION:**

# PCAR PART 2; 2.2.7 – LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY

- (c) As of 5 March 2008, airplane, airship, helicopter and powered-lift pilots, air traffic controllers and aeronautical station operators shall demonstrate the ability to speak and understand the language used for radiotelephony communications to the level specified in the language proficiency requirements as follows:
  - (1) those demonstrating language proficiency at the Operational Level (Level 4) should be evaluated at intervals not greater than 3 years;
  - (2) those demonstrating language proficiency at the Extended Level (Level 5) should be evaluated at intervals not greater than 6 years; and
  - (3) those demonstrating language proficiency at the Expert Level (Level 6) should be exempted from further language evaluation.

### AMENDED REGULATION:

## PCAR PART 2; 2.2.7 – LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY

(c) All airplane, airship, helicopter and powered-lift pilots, air traffic controllers and aeronautical station operators shall demonstrate the ability to speak and understand the language used for radiotelephony communications to the level specified in the language proficiency requirements as follows:

"The Juture is in the Skies"

- (1) those demonstrating language proficiency at the Operational Level (Level 4) shall no longer be evaluated.
- (2) those demonstrating language proficiency at the Extended Level (Level 5) shall no longer be evaluated.
- (3) those demonstrating language proficiency at the Expert Level (Level 6) shall be exempted from further language evaluation.

## **EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE:**

These amendments shall take effect (15) fifteen days after compliance with the requisite single newspaper publication and a copy filed with the U.P. Law Center – Office of the National Administrative Register.
