SUBJECT : **PROPOSED AMENDMENT OF PHILIPPINE CIVIL AVIATION REGULATIONS (PCAR) PART 2.3.1.5.1 ON THE LIMITATION OF PRIVILEGES OF PILOTS WHO HAVE ATTAINED THEIR 65TH BIRTHDAY (FROM THREE MONTHS MEDICAL CHECK-UP TO SIX MONTHS and EXEMPTIONS FROM COMMERCIAL AIR TRANSPORT OPERATIONS)**

REFERENCES:

1. Philippine Civil Aviation Regulations (PCAR) PART 2.3.1.5.1; and
2. The above PCAR provision is hereby amended to read as follows:

2.3.1.5.1 CURTAILMENT OF PRIVILEGES OF PILOTS WHO HAVE ATTAINED THEIR 65TH BIRTHDAY

- (a) No person who holds a pilot license under this Part shall serve as pilot-in-command or as co-pilot on a Philippine-registered civil aircraft engaged in commercial air transport if that person reached 65th years of age.
- (b) Any person beyond 65 years of age who holds a pilot license and a valid medical certificate under this Part may be allowed to fly as a pilot-in-command or co-pilot provided the flight is not in pursuance of commercial air transport operations, singly or collectively, and a mandatory CAAP medical check-up every _____ is complied with. (Note: Refer to Part 8.10.1.1)


This amendment shall take effect immediately upon compliance with the required publication and a copy filed with the UP Law Center – Office of the National Administrative Register.
