SUBJECT : Temporary Amendment of Subpart 2.3.1.5.1 of the Civil Aviation Regulations
PURPOSE : This Memorandum Circular is issued to inform all pilots of the Temporary amendment of Subpart 2.3.1.5.1 which states

CURTAILMENT OF PRIVILEGES OF PILOTS WHO HAVE ATTAINED THEIR 65TH BIRTHDAY.

No person who holds a pilot license issued under this Part shall serve as a pilot on a civil aircraft of the Republic of the Philippines registry engaged in domestic and international commercial air transport operations if that person has reached his or her 65th birthday.

CURTAILMENT OF PRIVILEGES OF PILOTS WHO HAVE ATTAINED THEIR 65TH BIRTHDAY.

No person who holds a pilot license issued under this Part shall serve as a pilot on a civil aircraft of the Republic of the Philippines registry engaged in international commercial air transport operations if that person has reached his or her 65th birthday.

No person who holds a pilot license issued under this Part shall serve as a pilot on a civil aircraft of the Republic of the Philippines registry engaged in domestic commercial air transport operations if that person has reached his or her 65th birthday, except in a multi-crew aircraft having maximum passenger capacity of nineteen (19) seats or in a multi-crew cargo aircraft having a maximum gross weight of 5,700 kgs. or 12,500 lbs.

EFFECTIVITY: This amendment is effective 15 days from date of publication in a newspaper of general circulation.
