Valid PCAB license with Category "C" in General Engineering as Principal Classification and Registration Particular "Small B" for Navigational Facilities.2. Certificate of Site Inspection signed by the ANS

List of contractor's major equipment units for the project such as Boring Machine with corresponding core bits, AGL Installation Jigs, Concrete Cutters, etc. which are owned, leased, and/or under purchase agreements, supported by proof of ownership, certification of availability of equipment from the equipment lessor/vendor for the duration of the project.</p> <p>Bids not complying with the above instructions shall be DISQUALIFIED.</p>

Technical Specifications</p> <p>Statement of Compliance</p> <p><i>[Bidders must state here either "Comply" or "Not Comply" against each of the individual parameters of each Specification stating the corresponding performance parameter of the equipment offered. Statements of "Comply" or "Not Comply" must be supported by evidence in a Bidders Bid and cross-referenced to that evidence. Evidence shall be in the form of manufacturer's un-amended sales literature, unconditional statements of specification and compliance issued by the manufacturer, samples, independent test data etc., as appropriate. A statement that is not supported by evidence or is subsequently found to be contradicted by the evidence presented will render the Bid under evaluation liable for rejection.
