**MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 026-2024**

**TO : ALL AOC HOLDERS, SHIPPERS, CARGO AGENCIES, FREIGHT FORWARDERS, GROUND HANDLING SERVICE PROVIDERS, AMOs and ATOs**

**SUBJECT : MANDATORY CAAP APPROVAL FOR THE HANDLING AND TRANSPORTATION OF DANGEROUS GOODS BY AIR**

In line with the Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines' ongoing efforts to strengthen compliance with national and international safety standards. All organization and individuals engaged in the transportation of Dangerous Goods by air shall secure prior approval from The CAAP. This compliance ensure alignment with Annex 18 of the Chicago Convention and PCAR Part 18.001(a)

To ensure compliance the following documents must be submitted to the Flight Operations Department for approval:

1. Dangerous Goods Procedure Manual
2. Dangerous Goods Training Program

Detailed guidelines can be found under Advisory Circular 18-002, 18-003, and 18-004.

This Memorandum Circular shall take effect immediately.

For all other Orders/Memoranda inconsistent herewith are hereby rescinded.
