



**REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR**  
**PROCUREMENT OF STRUCTURAL ENGINEERING ASSESSMENT, REVIEW AND**  
**RECERTIFICATION OF VARIOUS STRUCTURES AT LAGUINDINGAN AIRPORT**  
**Bid No. 25-14-03 BRAVO**

1. The Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines, through the CAAP CONTINGENCY FUND CY 2025 intends to apply the sum of **Seven Million Seven Hundred Twenty-Nine Thousand Fifty pesos only (Php 7,729,050.00)**, being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for **STRUCTURAL ENGINEERING ASSESSMENT, REVIEW AND RECERTIFICATION OF VARIOUS STRUCTURES AT LAGUINDINGAN AIRPORT (Bid No. 25-14-03 BRAVO)**. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at the opening of the financial proposals.
2. The CAAP now calls for the submission of eligibility documents for **STRUCTURAL ENGINEERING ASSESSMENT, REVIEW AND RECERTIFICATION OF VARIOUS STRUCTURES AT LAGUINDINGAN AIRPORT**. Eligibility documents of interested consultants must be duly received by the BAC Secretariat on or before **March 21, 2025 @ 9:30 AM** at BAC Office, CAAP Compound, MIA Road corner Ninoy Aquino Avenue, 1300 Pasay City, Metro Manila. Applications for eligibility will be evaluated based on a non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion.
3. Interested bidders may obtain further information from BAC Office, CAAP Compound, MIA Road corner Ninoy Aquino Avenue, 1300 Pasay City, Metro Manila and inspect the Bidding Documents at the address given below during 08:00 AM to 05:00 PM from MONDAY to FRIDAY.
4. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by interested bidders on **14 March 2025 until the deadline of submission of bid** from the address below and upon payment of the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents, pursuant to the latest Guidelines issued by the GPPB, in the amount of **Php 10,000.00 (exclusive of any/or taxes imposed by relevant government agencies)**.

It may also be downloaded free of charge from the website of the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) and the website of the Procuring Entity, provided that Bidders shall pay the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents not later than the submission of their bids.

5. Upon payment of the bid documents, bidders must provide their respective email addresses to the BAC Secretariat. All communications, including but not limited to Notices, Resolutions, and Replies, among others, will be sent to the email address provided by the bidder/s. The date when such email was sent shall be considered the



date of receipt of the bidder/s for purposes of complying with the requirements under RA 9184.

6. Bidders must also check the PhilGEPS website, CAAP website, and BAC Secretariat for any bid bulletins and announcements related to the bidding.
7. The BAC shall draw up the short list of consultants from those who have submitted Expression of Interest, including the eligibility documents, and have been determined as eligible in accordance with the provisions of Republic Act 9184 (RA 9184), otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act", and its Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR).

The short list shall consist of at least three (3) prospective bidders who will be entitled to submit bids. The criteria and rating system for short listing are:

2) Qualification of Key/Organic Personnel who may be Assigned to the Project	50
3) Job Capacity <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Absorptive capacity to do additional works other than those currently being undertaken</li> </ul>	20

8. Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using non-discretionary "pass/fail" criterion as specified in the IRR of RA 9184.

Bidding is open to all interested bidders, whether local or foreign, subject to the conditions for eligibility provided in the IRR of RA 9184.

9. The CAAP shall evaluate bids using the **Quality Cost Based Evaluation/Selection (QCBE/QCBS)** procedure. The technical and financial proposals shall be given weights at eighty percent (80%) and twenty percent (20%), respectively, for a total of one hundred percent (100%).
10. The contract shall be completed within **Forty-five (45) Calendar Days**.
11. The CAAP reserves the right to reject any and all bids, declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract at any time prior to contract award in accordance with Section 41 of RA 9184 and its IRR, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
