The Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines is launching the **Airfield Lighting and Power Technician's Course Batch 15** to recruit competent young men and women who will join the country's elite line of Air Navigation Technical Personnel.

A. General Qualifications:

- 1. Natural born citizen of the Philippines
- 2. At least twenty (20) years old but not more than twenty-eight (28) years old on June 14, 2025 (Qualified CAAP in-service applicants shall not be more than thirty-five (35) years of age on the day of examination)
- 3. Physically, mentally and psychologically fit and of good moral character
- 4. Has not been convicted of criminal or administrative case
- 5. Has not been dishonorably separated from Government or private service

B. Additional Qualifications:

- 1. Completion of two (2) years studies in college, preferably with Mechanical, Electrical, Electronics Course or High School Graduate with relevant vocation/Trade Course (Mechanical, Electrical, Electronics)
- 2. Not color blind

Application form may be downloaded from the CAAP website (<u>www.caap.gov.ph</u>) or requested from any designated CAAP Testing Centers.

Acceptance of applications will start on <u>April 07, 2025</u>. Interested applicants may submit either personally or via mail/courier, their <u>completed application form</u> together with the documents listed below, to the designated testing Centers in *Manila, Tuguegarao, Clark, Bicol, Bacolod, Kalibo, Mactan, Catarman, Zamboanga, Laguindingan, General Santos, Cotabato and Jolo* <u>on or before 5:00 PM of June 06, 2025</u>

- 1. Transcript of Records for two (2) years studies in college, a copy of diploma together with relevant Vocational/Trade Course Certificate *(authenticated copy)* for High School graduates
- 2. NBI Clearance/ Police Clearance (original copy)
- 3. 2 pcs 2x2 photo (colored picture with white background and name tag)

Applications with incomplete requirements will not be accepted.

Applicants must pass the nationwide examination on **June 14**, **2025** (**Saturday**), a scheduled interview and a medical exam on a later date.

Training is free. Allowances, accommodation and other miscellaneous expense during the training period shall <u>not</u> be covered by this Authority.

Successful applicants who will complete the training will be assigned to any Air Navigation Service (ANS) facility nationwide
