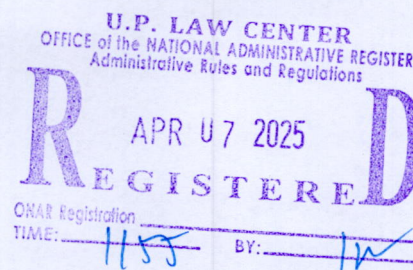

**REVISED SCHEDULE OF AIRPORT AND CONCESSION FEES AND  
CHARGES FOR ALL AIRPORTS UNDER THE CIVIL AVIATION  
AUTHORITY OF THE PHILIPPINES**

Pursuant to Sections 17, 24 (n), and 26 of Republic Act No. 9497 or the Civil Aviation Authority Act of 2008 which granted the Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines, through its Board of Directors, the power to determine and fix, landing fees, parking space fees, royalties on sales or deliveries, direct or indirect, to any aircraft for its use of aviation gasoline, oil and lubricants, spare parts, accessories and supplies, tools, other royalties, fees or rentals for the use of any of the property under its management and control.

**PART I. Definition of Terms**

Section 1. The following terminologies shall be construed to mean as follows:

1.1	Aircraft	Any contrivance now known or hereinafter invented, used or designed for navigation or flight in the air or any machine that can derive support from the atmosphere for flight.
1.2	Aircraft Parking Fee	A fee charged to aircraft for the use of facilities and services for parking at the terminal apron or remote parking areas from the time of landing up to the time of take-off.
1.3	Airport	Any area of land which is used or intended to be used for landing and take-off of aircraft including its appurtenant areas which are used or intended to be used for airport buildings installation or the airport facilities or

1.4	CAAP	Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines
1.5	CAAP Board	The Board of Directors of the Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines.
1.6	Concessionaire	A company or individual allowed by the CAAP, through a contract or permit, to operate and maintain business activity within CAAP-operated airports.
1.7	Director General	The Director General of the Civil Aviation Authority of the Philippines.
1.8	Developed Area	An area that has an access road and/or where improvements are already introduced.
1.9	Domestic Flight	Air transportation within the limits of the Philippine Territory.
1.10	International Flight	Air transportation between two or more countries.
1.11	Landing and Take-off Fees	Charges for the use of any strip or runway by any aircraft landing or taking off at any CAAP operated airport.
1.12	Maximum Take-off Weight (MTOW)	The aircraft certificated maximum take-off weight specified in the license of a particular aircraft by the licensing authority
1.13	Nighttime	The time between 6:00 PM and 6:00 AM (local time).
1.14	Transit Passenger	A passenger who arrives and departs in the airport in the same aircraft and is travelling via the airport to a different destination from their point of origin on a single ticket

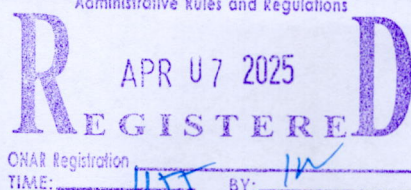

## PART II. General Provisions

**Section 1. Applicability** – The fees and charges prescribed herein shall apply for the use of all CAAP-operated airports, the facilities, services, utilities and properties under the management and control of the CAAP.

**Section 2. Effects on Existing Contract** – The fees and charges prescribed herein shall not affect the contract, leases or concession permits executed or approved





prior to the effectivity of this Memorandum Circular, except when otherwise provided in the contract, leases, or permits

**Section 3. Exemption** – As a general rule, Philippine Government agencies operating within the airport shall pay rentals due including electric and water bills to the CAAP for the use of office space and working area which they occupy. However, Philippine Government offices whose services are essential to the operations of the airport as determined by the CAAP, upon recommendation by the respective Airport Manager, subject to the approval of the CAAP Board, shall be exempt from payments of rentals only in respect of that necessary space:

**Section 4. Other Fees and Charges** – The fees and charges prescribed herein shall not prejudice the right of the CAAP to impose and collect such other reasonable charges as may be determined by the Director General for the use of such properties, facilities, and services in CAAP-operated airports.

**Section 5. Rules of Payment** - The fees and charges prescribed herein shall be due and payable on the following dates:

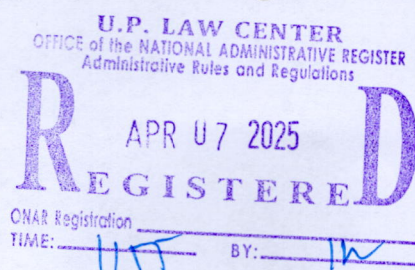
- a. Fixed charges (Rental, CPF, etc.): within the month for which the charges are due unless provided otherwise
- b. Fixed, pre specified percentage of gross revenues derived from operation at the airport (CPF, Royalty fee, etc.): within the first fifteen (15) days of the succeeding month
- c. Non-fixed charges/based on usage: within 15 days from receipt of billing

Delayed payments shall be subject to an interest rate of 12% per annum of the outstanding balance from the due date.

**Section 6. Application of Payment** – Payment received shall be applied first on the interests, thereafter on the principal.

**Section 7. Value Added Tax (VAT) Charges** – All CAAP charges as prescribed herein shall be subject to the applicable Value Added Tax (VAT) as prescribed under the National Internal Revenue Code unless clearly specified that the rates are already VAT inclusive.

**Section 8. Rates billed in US Dollar currency** - Fees quoted in US Dollars may be paid in Philippine Peso equivalent at the prevailing Banker's Association of the Philippines (BAP) closing rate on the day prior to the date of payment.





### **PART III. Aeronautical Fees and Charges**

Aircraft that operate at CAAP-operated airports shall be levied with the appropriate fees and charges for the use of various facilities such as runways, taxiways, apron areas, and lighting facilities.

**Section 1. Landing and Take-off Fees** – Landing and Take-off fees for International or Domestic flights shall be based on the maximum take-off weight of the aircraft as follows:

#### **1.1 International Flights:**

Basis: Fees are computed based on the aircraft certified Maximum Take-off Weight per landing and take-off.

<b>Aircraft Weight (in KGs) based on MTOW</b>	<b>Rates in U.S. (\$)</b>
Up to 50,000 kgs	Minimum \$260.00
Above 50,000 kgs	\$260.00 plus \$3.20 / 500 kgs or fraction thereof over 50,000 kgs

#### **1.2 Domestic Flights**

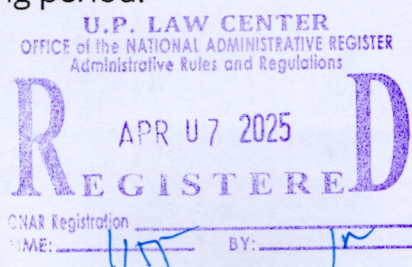
Basis: Fees are computed based on the aircraft certified Maximum Take-off Weight and per landing and take-off.

<b>Aircraft Weight (in KGs) based on MTOW</b>	<b>Rates in PHP</b>
Up to 50,000 kgs	Php54.00 per 500 kgs
Above 50,000 kgs	Php5,400.00 plus Php67.00/ 500 kgs or fraction thereof over 50,000 kgs

**Section 2. Aircraft Parking Fees** – Parking fees for International or Domestic flights shall be computed as follows:

#### **2.1 International Flights**

Basis: Fees are computed based on the aircraft certified Maximum Take-off Weight (MTOW) and the number of hours parked after the first two (2) hours free parking period.

Up to 50,000 kgs	Each additional half hour thereafter or fraction thereof	\$4.60

Above 100,000 kgs	Each additional half hour thereafter or fraction thereof	\$8.70

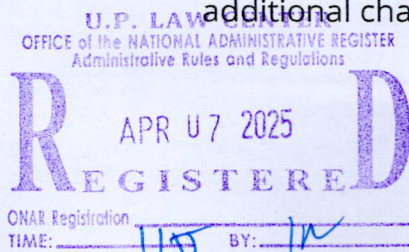
## 2.2 Domestic Flights

Basis: Fees are computed based on the aircraft certified Maximum Take-off Weight and the number of hours parked after the first one (1) hour free parking period.

Aircraft Weight (in KGs) based on MTOW	Time Frame	Rates
All aircraft regardless of weight	First one (1) hour	Free
	First half hour or fraction thereof after one hour	PHP364.00
Up to 50,000 kgs	Each additional half hour thereafter or fraction thereof	PHP36.00
From 50,001 kgs to 100,000 kgs	Each additional half hour thereafter or fraction thereof	PHP84.00
Above 100,000 kgs	Each additional half hour thereafter or fraction thereof	PHP97.00

## Section 3. Lighting Charges

3.1 An aircraft that lands and takes off during night time, between 6:00 PM to 6:00 AM (local time), shall be levied an additional charge of fifteen percent (15%) of the applicable landing and take-off charges; or, an additional charge of ten percent (10%) if:





- a) The landing was made before nighttime and the subsequent take-off was made during nighttime; or,
- b) The landing was made at nighttime and the subsequent take-off was made during daylight hours.

3.2 For an aircraft that parks at night time between 6:00 PM and 6:00 AM shall be charged an additional fifteen percent (15%) of applicable parking charges.

**Section 4. Tacking Fees<sup>1</sup>** – Aircraft using the loading bridges shall be charged with the following fees:

International flights	\$30.00 / tube / hour or fraction thereof
Domestic flights	PHP1,300.00 / tube / hour or fraction thereof

**Section 5. Passenger Service Charge** – Fees charged for each departing passenger in accordance with the following rates, except:

- a) Children below two (2) years of age at the time of departure
- b) Overseas Filipino Worker (for international flight only)
- c) Transit Passenger
- d) Passenger who was denied entry

Any passenger refusing or failing to pay the required passenger service charge shall be prevented from boarding the aircraft.

<sup>1</sup> Note that under CAAP Memorandum Circular No. 23-13 dated 8 March 2013, the use of aerobridges has been declared as mandatory in the carrying and/or offloading of passengers where they are available. Each recorded violation or deliberate refusal of air carrier personnel to use an aerobridge whenever one is declared available for its use by the Authority shall result in an assessment of Fifty Thousand Pesos (PHP50,000.00) against the erring commercial air carrier, in accordance with Section 82 of Republic Act No. 9497.

## Section 6. Exemptions

Basis: Unless otherwise specifically provided, the fees and charges provided herein shall not apply to the following:

- 6.1 Aircraft registered and/or operated by the Government of the Republic of the Philippines solely for government functions;
- 6.2 State-owned aircraft exclusively used by diplomatic and consular representatives of foreign governments.  
(Civil registered aircraft other than state-owned aircraft, which are chartered or hired by representatives, or personnel of foreign governments are not exempted by this provision);
- 6.3 Aircraft engaged in humanitarian mission for the particular flight;
- 6.4 Flight diverted due to in-flight emergency;
- 6.5 Aircraft which, by virtue of existing laws or treaties, are exempted from the payment of fees and charges;
- 6.6 Aircraft required to land at any CAAP-operated airport due to Air Traffic Control (ATC) or other administrative requirements; and,
- 6.7 Other non-revenue flights as may be exempted by the Director General.

## PART IV. Concession Fees and Charges

**Section 1. Terminal Buildings** – Rental of floor spaces at the Passenger Terminal Building shall be in accordance with the following:

**Section 2. Check-in Counters and Concession Counter** – Rental charges for the use of the Check-in counters and Concession counters shall be in accordance with the following rates:

Notwithstanding the foregoing, the minimum lease rate as provided above, the prevailing market rate, or best offer shall be applied, whichever is higher.

**Section 3. Use of VIP Lounges** – a fee of PHP 3,500.00 / hour or a fraction thereof shall be imposed for the use of VIP Lounges, with the exception of the following:

- Heads of State
- Cabinet Members and Justices of the Supreme Court
- Member of the Diplomatic Corps endorsed by the Protocol Officer of the Department of Foreign Affairs
- Other local and foreign officials who may be extended courtesy usage by the Director General or his duly authorized representatives

**Section 4. Other Airport Buildings and Hangars** – Lease/Rental of CAAP owned buildings other than the passenger / cargo terminal buildings, inclusive of the land area occupied by said building, shall be charged as follows:

**Section 5. Land / Lot Space** – Lease / Rental for land / lot space located within CAAP owned airports and facilities shall be charged the following rates:

Notwithstanding the foregoing, the minimum lease rate as provided above, the prevailing market rate, or best offer shall be applied, whichever is higher.

## **PART V. Concession Privilege Fees**

**Section 1. Concession Privilege Fees (CPF)** – All business conducted within CAAP owned or operated airports and facilities shall be levied with a Concession Privilege Fee. It shall be charged against any type of business or commercial activity notwithstanding the use of the same space for other business located within its vicinity. Concession Privilege Fees shall be separate from the charges for rentals of floor space, buildings and/or land spaces and according to the following schedule:

## **PART VI. Utilities**

**Section 1. Electric Power Charges** – Lessees and/or tenants of the buildings and/or spaces shall be charged for their electrical consumption based on actual meter reading plus 15% maintenance and service fee but not less than PHP 450.00 / month.

**Section 2. Water Charges** – Lessees and/or tenants of buildings and/or spaces shall be charged for the water consumption based on the actual meter reading plus 15% maintenance and service fee.

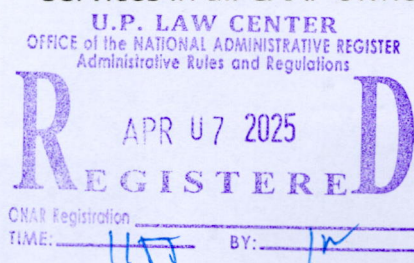
**Section 3. Garbage Collection Fee** – A Garbage Collection Fee shall be levied to all lessees and concessionaires at a rate of 1.5% of the rental rate for Food Service; and, 1% of the rental rate for non-Food Service; provided however, that the minimum fee shall not be less than PHP 350.00 / month.

## **PART VII. Other Airport Fees and Charges**

**Section 1. Royalty Fee on the Sale of Aviation Fuel, Oil, and Grease** – A royalty fee shall be imposed on any person, firm, or corporation, selling or delivering, directly or indirectly, aviation fuel, oil, or grease at the airport for their use, at the following rates:

Grease	PHP 4.00 / liter

**Section 2. Royalty Fee for Cargoes**– A royalty fee shall be imposed on any person, firm or corporation engaged in the business of providing cargo handling services in all CAAP owned or operated airports using airport facilities.

**Section 3. Ground Handling Service Fees** – A fee shall be charged for the use of the ramp facilities in accordance with the following schedule:

	Rates
Ground Handling Service	7% of monthly gross revenues but not less than PHP12,500.00 / month
In-Flight Catering Service	7% of monthly gross revenues
Repair and Maintenance Services	7% of monthly gross revenues

**Section 4. Advertising Fees** – Business in the form of signboards, displays, billboards, posters, streamers, etc., may be installed within the airport premises subject to the approval of the Director General or his duly authorized representatives. Location signboard or corporate signature sign of concessionaires within their respective leased premises are exempt from the payment of advertising charges provided that their size, design and location are approved by the Authority. The advertising rates are exclusive of electricity and other utilities chargeable to the concessionaires.

Unless otherwise specifically provided, the fees and charges cited herein shall not apply to the following:

- a. Philippine military aircraft and other aircraft which by law or treaty are exempted from the payment of fees and charges cited herein;
- b. Foreign-owned aircraft on diplomatic mission;
- c. Aircraft landing due to in-flight emergency;
- d. Other aircraft landing and/or take off that may be authorized by the Authority.

## Section 9. Telephone, Cable Pairs, and Right-of-Way for Communication Facilities

**Section 10. Height Clearance Permit and Limitation Assessment Fee** - A fee of PHP 6,400.00 (VAT inclusive) shall be charged-for each application for Height Clearance/limitation permit.

**Section 11. Vehicular Parking Fee** - All motor vehicles, regardless of types, shall be charged for the use of vehicular parking areas in accordance with the following rates:

**Section 12. Airport Operation Extension Fee** - A user fee for the extension of operations of airports for airlines or aircraft operators who intend to arrive / depart at an aerodrome beyond the published hours of operations shall be charged the following rates, and provided the following conditions are met:

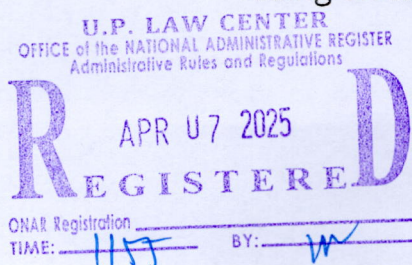
- a. At least a 24-hour prior notice shall be made relative thereto;
- b. An advance payment is required by the Authority and is non-refundable.

**Section 13. Airside Driver's Violations, Penalties and Fines** – The following table describes the violations of the different categories with the corresponding fines:

### 13.1 Driver Based Violations

#### 13.1.1 Minor Violations with fine of PHP2,000.00 per violation

Failure to observe vehicle lane  
 Illegal dumping of Unit Load Device (ULD)  
 Towing more than four (4) small dollies or three (3) big dollies  
 Improper transport of baggage (towing of defective dollies, towing of open containers /carts)  
 Failure to use restraining nets on containers without proper enclosure  
 Failure to use beacon lights (at airside)  
 Obstruction of vehicular lane and other areas  
 Overloading of tug riders  
 No seat, no ride  
 Failure to use restraining materials  
 Leaving vehicle at movement area while engine is running  
 Driving vehicle without or with expired Ground Support Equipment Control Number / Airside Vehicle Permit (GSECN/AVP)  
 Use of mobile communication device while driving  
 Unauthorized beacon color  
 Illegal parking  
 Riding on tailgate





13.1.2 Major Violations with fine of PHP10,000.00 per violation.

- Driving vehicle without or expired Airside Driver's Permit (ADP)
- Illegal transfer / use of ADP
- Failure to maintain proper distance from moving aircraft
- Violation of airside color access limit
- Parking within aerobridge safety perimeter area
- Unauthorized entry of vehicle at terminal baggage build-up / breakdown areas
- Over speeding
- Reckless driving
- No CAAP Access Pass
- Ferrying of unauthorized person/s at airside
- Failure to yield to moving aircraft
- Unauthorized crossing / entry of vehicle at runway / taxiway

13.1.3 Other Violations with fine of PHP2,000.00 per violation

- Using unauthorized horn / siren
- Passing through non-load bearing areas

13.2 Vehicle Based Violations

13.2.1 Minor Violations with a fine of PHP2,000.00 per violation.

- No / Faded prescribed ground equipment marking
- Defective beacon light
- Defective vehicle lights (signal, tail, or headlights)
- No back horn for ground equipment
- No fire extinguisher
- Improperly parked dollies / carts (If driver is not identified, penalty is per dolly / cart)

13.2.2 Major Violations with a fine of PHP10,000.00 per violation.

- Transfer / Use of airside vehicle / ground support equipment control number sticker/permit (GSECN)
- Abandoned stalled vehicle or ground support equipment
- No airside vehicle permit / ground support equipment sticker / permit
- Use of defective dolly / cart
- Use of dilapidated ground support equipment



Unescorted motor vehicle  
Spill of oil and other lubricants

#### **PART VIII. Effects of Non-Payment**

Without prejudice to such action and/or proceedings as may be deemed proper and necessary, the failure of any person, firm, or corporation to pay any fees or charges upon demand by CAAP shall be ground to enforce the following remedies until compliance or payment:

- a. Rejection of flight plans and denial of the use of the facilities and services of CAAP
- b. Suspension of CAAP issued Certificates such as Certificate of Registration, Certificate of Airworthiness and other licenses issued by the Authority
- c. Enforcement of lien against properties of the debtor as authorized by RA 9497 and other international laws and conventions as applicable
- d. The remedies enumerated herein does not preclude CAAP from enforcing its rights through all applicable laws

#### **PART IX. Repealing Provisions**

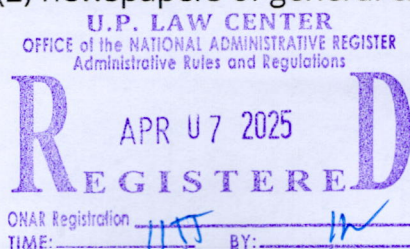
All previous Orders, Rules and Regulations or part thereof as they pertain to fees and charges for airport area, facilities and other services, which are inconsistent with any provisions herein, are deemed repealed, amended or modified accordingly.

#### **PART X. Separability Provisions**

The provisions of this Memorandum Circular are hereby declared separable. If any portion thereof shall be held invalid or unconstitutional, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the other provisions which shall remain in full force and effect.

#### **PART XI. Effectivity**


This Memorandum Circular shall take effect fifteen (15) days after the publication in two (2) newspapers of general circulation, and submission of copies thereof to
